

LA ESPERANZA PROSPECT



GOLDEN GOOSE RESOURCES

The **La Esperanza Prospect** is located in the Los Menucos District, within the **Río Negro Province of Argentina**. The project lies in the Norpatagonian Massif, a region known for its potential to host precious metal deposits.

Exploration History

A total of **30 trenches** were excavated, exposing **2,936.6 m** and yielding **690 continuous channel samples**.

In total, **1,674 rock samples** were collected, including rock chips, channel chip samples, and float samples.

Location and Access

La Esperanza, covers **44,400 ha** of **year round workable land** in Río Negro, Argentina.

Access: 2 km from a provincial route in gentle slope terrain

Nearby activity: To the south, Southern Copper holds a **ready-to-drill target** adjacent to Golden Goose Resources claims.

Geology & Mineralization

Main feature: Over 10 km of **low-sulfidation epithermal gold veins**, averaging 1 m in width and ranging from 50 to 2,500 m in length.

Textures: Classic low-sulfidation multi-pulse features – drusy quartz, banding, crustiform textures, and carbonate replacement.
