

Course description

We are all ready to welcome 1000 runners for our first ever Big Bear Run 10k on the 16th of August! The event is hosted by Curly's Athletes in partnership with Askham Bryan Wildlife & Conservation Park and Askham Bryan College in support of the Project Moon Bear charity ☺ to support fundraising and raise awareness of their amazing work.



The event starts within Askham Bryan College Grounds.

They head out onto York Road and turn north to the village of Askham Richard, here they pass the duck pond and be greeted by incredible members of the community at the water station and general cheering!

Heading out the village they then turn west towards Seakel Lane then South towards York Road and past The Normans!

They then turn east onto Moor Road and head through Back Road past our second aid station manned by the local community at Country Classrooms!

Continuing east through the village and out onto Cat Lane, turn then north back to York Road, turning East and heading back into the college grounds for an incredible finish!
