## Did You Know?

- Garbage collection days: Monday & Thursday
- Out of cart waste collection on Monday only for bulky items, bagged leaves and yard waste
- Bundles of brush must be grouped or stacked, not to exceed 5 feet in length or 40 pounds in weight
- Maximum of 3 bulk waste items on each Monday
- Professionals who cut trees are required to haul away waste.
- Excluded pickup items: hazardous waste, demo and construction waste, fencing and eviction waste
