She served with a smile and always found time in her busy professional and personal life to handle the details of our finances and help funds stretch further.

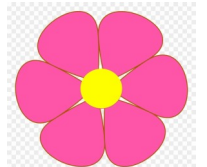
One of Christy's favorite aspects of serving on the board was the opportunity to meet and get to know Parkview Oaks neighbors.
