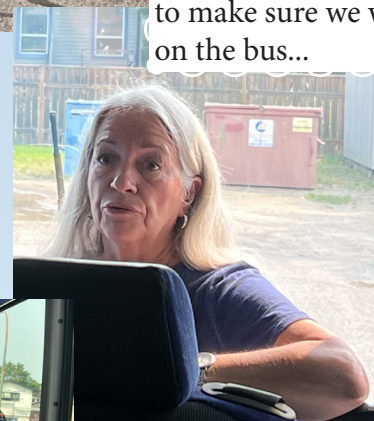

WELCOME TO ROSEBUD'S HISTORY

JOIN US FOR AN HISTORICAL TOUR through Rosebud – a journey which will take you through our town as it was about a century ago. Land seekers first arrived in the area in 1885; many more soon followed. This, along with the arrival of the railroad in 1914, contributed to the vibrant social and commercial life the town (then known as 'Rosebud Creek') developed by the 1920's. Follow the sign tour through Rosebud and learn more about some of the businesses, organizations and families that contributed so much to our history.

CHINESE RESTAURANT

THE CHINESE RESTAURANT is a staple of small towns across Western Canada. Many Chinese immigrants settled and set up business in the communities which popped up along the railway as it made its way westward. Rosebud got its first taste of the Orient in 1917 when Charlie Chong opened a Chinese restaurant next to Mah Joe's laundry. Charlie remained in business here until 1932. Thereafter, the building was repurposed as a community hall, fittingly named the Oriental Gardens. It hosted many wedding dances, farewells and celebrations of all kinds, including those welcoming home soldiers who served in World War II.

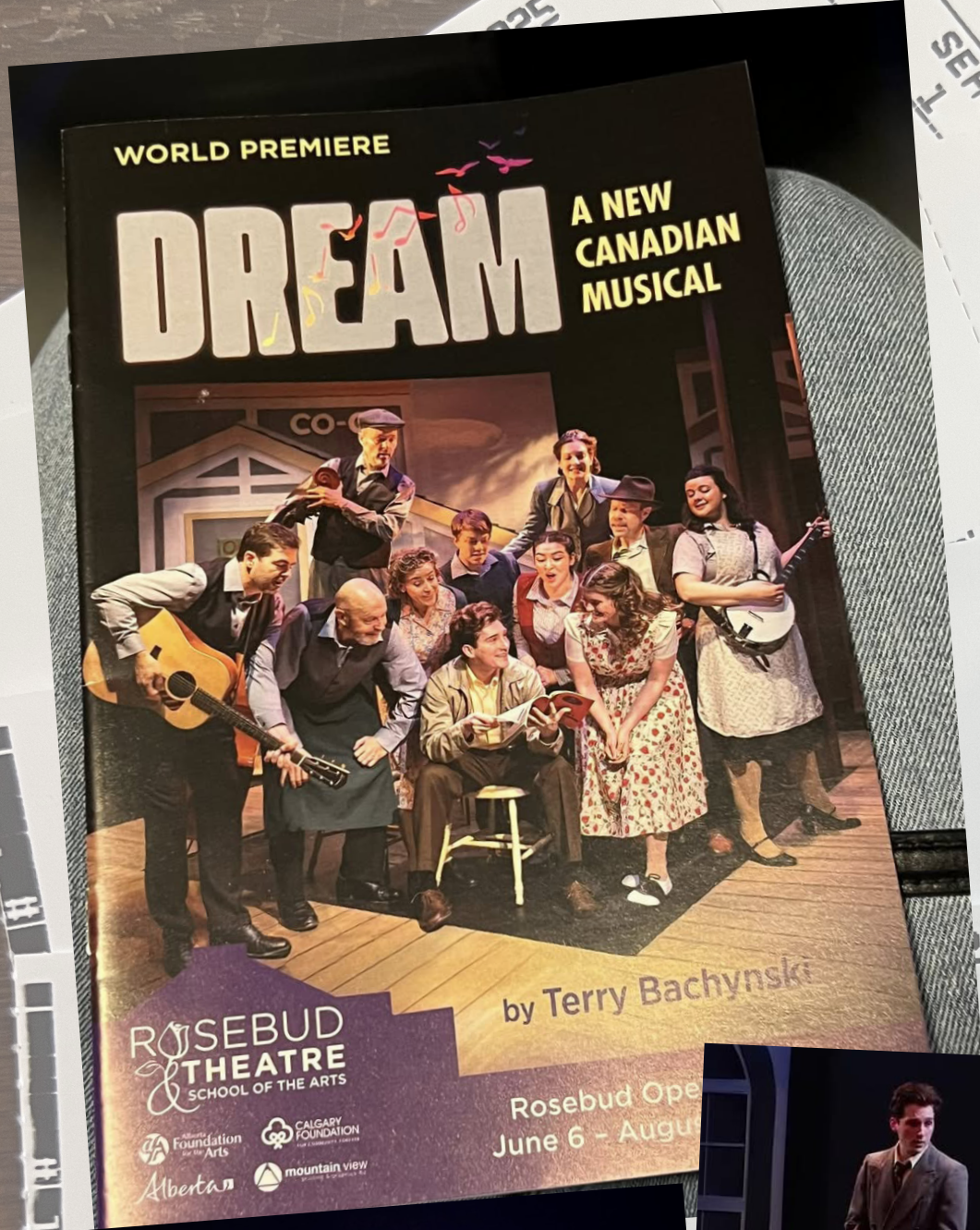
