Public Relations/Advocacy/Resolutions

At our February STS Saskatoon Chapter meeting members voted to approve two resolutions to be submitted to the STS Provincial Resolutions Committee for inclusion at the 2025 STS AGM on May 13 to 15, 2025.

RESOLUTIONS for AGM 2025 from Saskatoon Chapter

- 1. **BE IT RESOLVED THAT** that the STS consider amending the Extended Health Plan, Vision-Care Benefits, to add coverage for an annual eye exam for all patients over 65 years of age.
- 2. **BE IT RESOLVED THAT** that the STS consider amending the Extended Health Plan, Co-insurance 80%, Hearing Aids and Cochlear Implants (\$2,000 every six calendar years) to (\$2,000 every four calendar years).

The Provincial STS AGM will be held at Dakota Dunes. Approximately two hundred Delegates from 40 Chapters will meet and discuss resolutions that advocate for the interests and welfare of all STS members. This is also an opportunity for Delegates to be updated on various items related to our organization.






