Stan was one of the founding fathers of SVVSCC. He was at the meeting when the club "inherited" the British Car Show called the "Meeting of the Marques" aka MOM. After SVVSCC became official several months after our first MOM, the club already was in the process of a second endeavor, the first "Hershey Vintage Hillclimb". Stan was the Public Relations Representation for the club and was a major contributor to its success for the eight years it ran.

MOM after many years as a British Car Show, became "Meeting of the Marques International Concourse". A multi marque car show but to be true to its beginning, has four British Classes and one British Motorbike class, along-side a North American, European, Asian and a Wild Card class. For about five years, the club turned MOM into a two-day event. The first day was "Artistry on Wheels", the car show. The second day was "Artistry in Motion" a road rally/tour event. In the end MOM has flourished for 25 years since SVVSCC took it over. This achievement is mostly because of Stan's direct leadership and planning for the future.

It was a joy to work a car show with Stan as he would never shy away from promoting vintage cars to passerby's who would stop to look at his gorgeous 1972 Jaguar E-Type automobile, which he named the "Silver Bullet." He would allow young folks to sit in it and dream of maybe owning a car like that someday.
