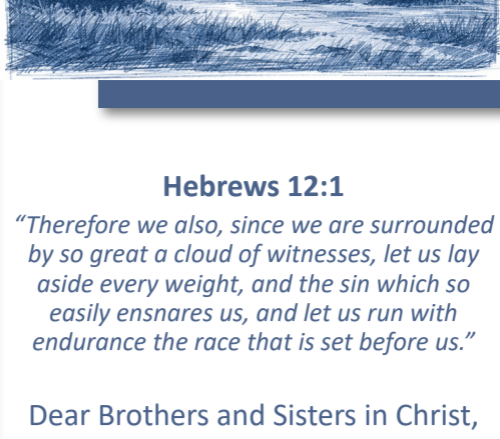

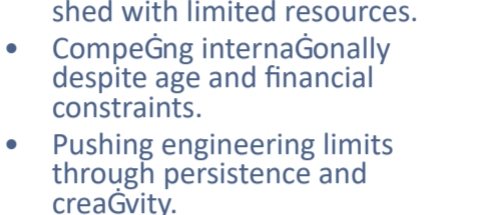
Hebrews 12:1

- Pushing engineering limits through persistence and creativity.

God spoke to me through this movie. I just felt Him say, dream big, stay focussed (persevere) and depend on Him. Don't let the enemy say you're too old or too young. Shut his lies out and look forward!!

I want to encourage you, many of whom have your own businesses and ministries. Don't give up, even when people don't believe in the dream God has laid on your heart. Persevere, pray and trust in our Lord.

Like Burt made an impact for speed, we're here to make a spiritual impact for the Good News. Everlasting fruit. Amen!!

Report Summary

Summary from 1 January to 31 March 2026:

- Printed **30,000 “Please Free Me”** gospel tracts in Q1:
 - 5 print jobs.
 - 4 new distributors.
 - 1 new country (Lesotho).
 - 3 new languages translated (Kirundi for Burundi), (French for Burundi) and (Amharic for Ethiopia). Hopefully printing for Burundi and Ethiopia to commence soon.

- Current ‘back-order’ demand for tracts = **315,000**. Praise God!!
- Average AU\$ per tract = \$0.08 = **\$25,200** to meet the demand.

Highlights

Key Highlights:

- **New Country Expansion** - We were contacted by Leonce in Burundi, which is a new country for us. Not only did Leonce want to translate the Please Free Me tract into Kirundi, he also wanted to volunteer for Strengthen Africa. Now, we have a team meeting each week with Leonce, Danny and myself. Praise God!!
- **New Country Expansion** - We were contacted by Addis from Ethiopia. He has worked with us to translate the Please Free Me tract into Amharic. He has a great influence in Ethiopia and I believe the Lord will leverage this relationship. We're seeking printers for these tracts in Amharic.
- **Website** - We are busy transferring the Strengthen Africa website platform to provide more technical flexibility in growing.
- **Awareness** - Danny and I were invited to present the Strengthen Africa journey at a home-group in Adelaide. The beloved group enjoyed hearing about Strengthen Africa and have decided to start a collection for the work. So wonderful, we thank the Lord!!
- **Awareness** - Danny, myself and Leonce have decided to start reaching out to pastors, Christian Business Owners, believers and organisations to seek their support.
- **Existing Country Expansion** - God has shown us how we can utilise existing relationships with distributors to grow in-country distribution of the gospel message. Thanks to this strategy, Q1 demand in Malawi alone is almost equal to everything we printed in 2025! It pleases the Lord to give strategies and wisdom to His children.
- **Setting 2026 Goals** - We have agreed goals. See below.
