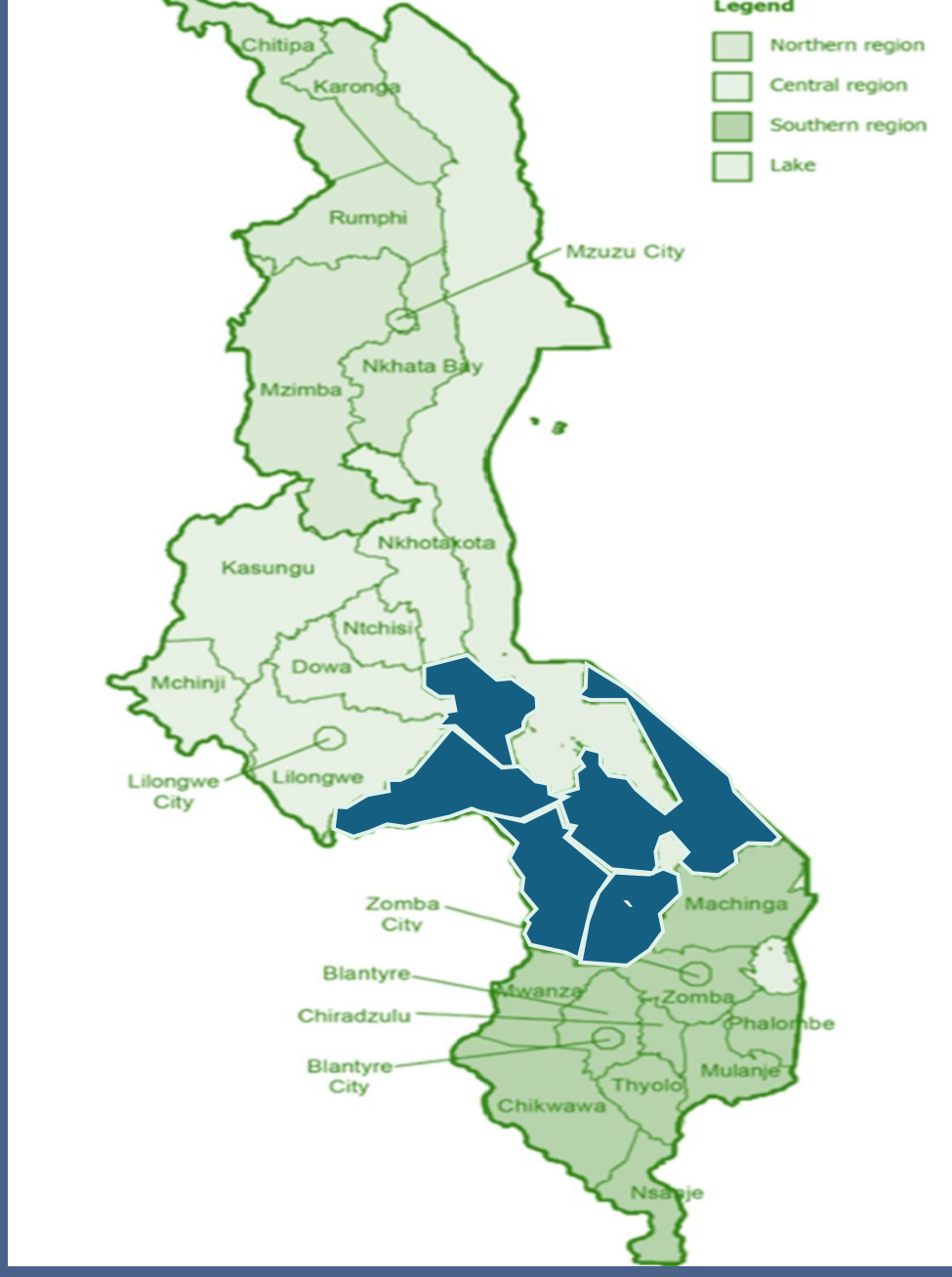

## FEATURED – PLANNING OF GOSPEL CRUSADE IN MALAWI

## 1- Welcome and Report Summary

Dear fellow Servant of the Lord.

In **2 Kings 3:16–17**, the Lord, through the prophet Elisha, instructs the Israelites to dig ditches in preparation for a miraculous provision of water—which the Lord indeed supplies.

This passage illustrates that God chooses to work in partnership with His people. He does not act in isolation; rather, He invites us to participate in His work. As we faithfully fulfill our responsibilities, we do so with the confident expectation that God will fulfill His—producing lasting, eternal fruit.

### Report Summary:

- New Partners:**
  - We have supported one new partner in South Africa with tracts in Q2 2025.
  - We, through Lucas who is an existing partner, have contacted five new partners as we prepare for the gospel crusade in the 5 districts in Malawi from 20 to 24 August 2025.
- Tract Printing:**
  - 65,250 tracts were printed in Q2 2025. Total printed for the year = 72,750.
  - We are on track to print the targeted 120,000 tracts by the end of 2025.
- Sponsorship Income:**
  - Thank you to those who have supported this work through prayer and financial support.
  - Q2 Printing and gospel related costs = \$4,720.55.
  - Q2 Actual sponsorship income = \$898.90.
  - This work can't move forward without your support. Every \$ helps.

## 2- Q2 Highlights

### HIGHLIGHT 1

**Preparing for Gospel Crusade to be held 20 to 24 August 2025 in Malawi (5x pastors, 5x districts, 5x days)**

Supporting pastors with tracts is one way to strengthen the work in Africa. Gospel crusades are powerful in bringing pastors together with a vision and a purpose. The crusade links the pastors together and builds relationships.

Lucas (one of our current partners in Malawi), felt led by the Lord to organize a gospel crusade. We put our heads together and decided that August (winter) will be a good month to have the crusade. We agreed to plan the crusade over five days in five districts, with five pastors participating. Have you ever wondered what goes into planning a GOSPEL CRUSADE? We're still learning, but this is what we have learned so far:

### Steps Taken to Plan the Crusade in Malawi:

- 1- Set the Date** – Determined the most suitable time of year and finalise the dates.
- 2- Select Locations** – Identified the key districts where the crusade will be held.
- 3- Engage Local Pastors** – Lucas met with pastors in each district to confirm interest and secure collaboration on pre-crusade outreach efforts (e.g., invitations, posters, daily crusade agenda and church networking).
- 4- Prepare and Translate Gospel Materials** – Design, translate, print, and transport tracts to Lilongwe from South Africa. Lucas to make the three-hour journey to collect them personally from Lilongwe.



## 5- Create Custom Stamps

We produced individualized stamps for each pastor to stamp on the gospel material in their respective regions (also handy for future tract distribution).



**6- Logistics Coordination** – Book the SOUND equipment (a local DJ for all five days), arrange transportation for Lucas’ team, and ensure meals are provided for the pastors.

**7- Ongoing Prayer** – Maintain consistent prayer support from all involved throughout the planning and execution process.

*To date, we have spent \$1,800 and we will require your support to raise another \$2,000 to complete the 5-day campaign.*
