2021 ASM Grant Information

Adolescent Sports Metrics (ASM) is offering **TWO (2)** \$2,000.00 grants to graduating, Dallas, TX area high school seniors. While we understand that not every student is college bound, we do know that every student has graduation needs. These grants are intended to help reduce the financial burden for a couple of young adults in our local community and therefore, do NOT need to be used or applied towards higher education.

Eligibility

All high school seniors located in Dallas County graduating before or by June 30, 2021 are eligible. There is no GPA requirement or any other stipulation other than students must meet the state requirement for being a high school graduate. Graduation and verification of graduation required before grant awarded.

Application Deadline Date

All ASM Grant application submissions are due before or by 11:59PM on Wednesday, June 30, 2021.

Awards

ASM is offering **TWO (2)** \$2,000.00 grants to Dallas County high school seniors graduating before or by June 30, 2021. These grants are intended to help reduce the financial burden for a couple of young adults in our local community and therefore, do NOT need to be used or applied towards higher education.

Rules & Requirements:

- 1. The Senior must be nominated by an ON CAMPUS ATHELTIC TRAINER (AT). **One (1) nomination per school.** The AT's nomination must be provided in writing on official campus letterhead.
- The AT should notify the student of his/her nomination for an ASM Grant so that the <u>STUDENT</u> can gather the required documents. The student must email the required documents to the AT so that the AT can then submit those documents by email to <u>admin@adolescentsportsmetrics.org</u> by **11:59PM on Wednesday, June 30, 2021**.
- 3. All grant submission documents should be either compiled into ONE (1) Portable Document Format (PDF) file OR attached as individual Portable Document Format (PDF) files to ONE (1) submission email. Incomplete submissions, missing one or more required documents, will not be considered.
- 4. Graduation is required. There is no GPA requirement or any other stipulation other than you must meet the state requirement for being a high school graduate.

5. **<u>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS</u>**:

- a. Nomination Letter from your On-Campus Athletic Trainer written/signed on official campus letterhead.
- b. THREE (3) Letters of Recommendation:
 - i. ONE (1) Letter of Recommendation from a Head Coach that the student engaged with while participating in UIL competitions.
 - ii. ONE (1) Letter of Recommendation from an academic teacher (English, Math, CORE course only).
 - iii. ONE (1) Letter of Recommendation from a community member. **CANNOT** be a family member. (*Hint: Think outside-the-box and beyond yourself. Have you participated in an event/activity that benefitted your community, an organization or something greater than yourself?*)
- c. A 500-word essay. Tell us why/what/when/where/how you intend to use the \$2,000.00 award should you be chosen as the winner. We want to know your dreams. A dream written down becomes a goal!
