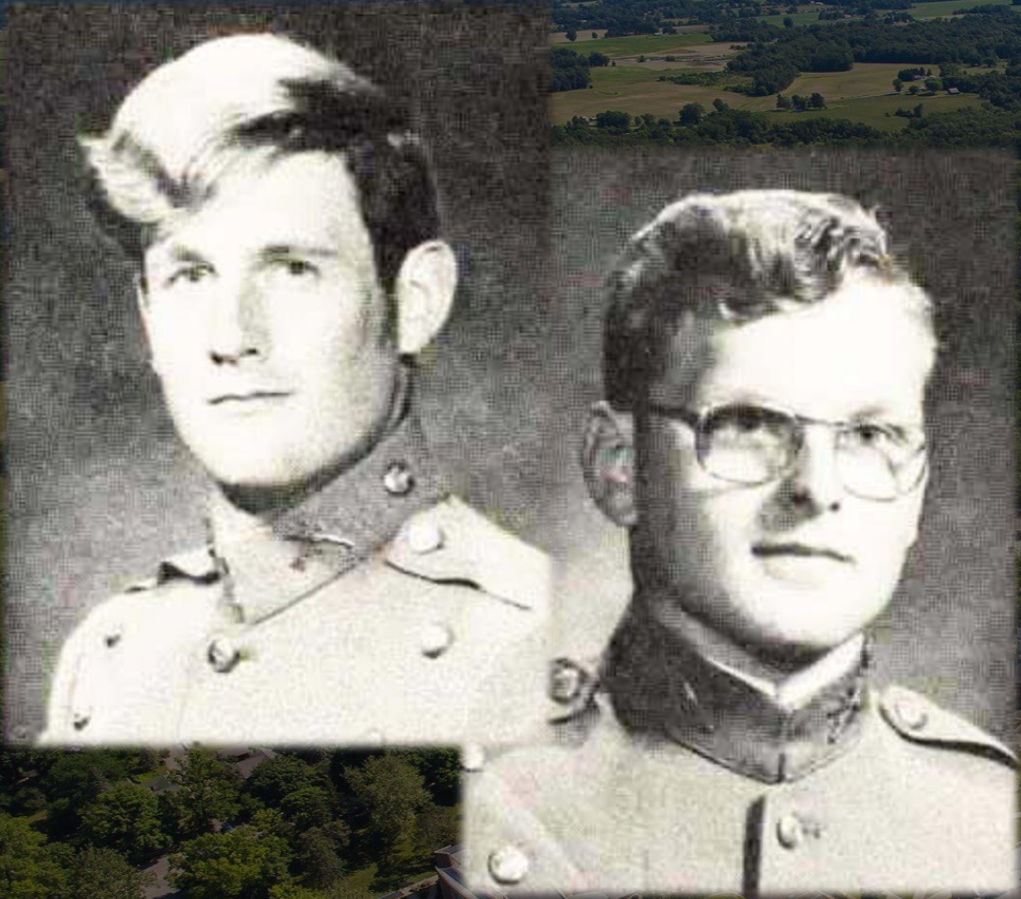

This year the team boasts four of the top ten canoeists in Indiana. The team has recently scheduled races in Crawfordsville, Greenville, South Bend, and Elkhart.

The first race, Crawfordsville, is four days after Spring Vacation. The canoeists will compete in C-1 and C-4 one-thousand-meter sprints, a slalom course, an eleven mile mixed race, and then finish with a seventeen mile junior mens race.

Canoe Trip Tomorrow Ends 3-Race Season

After only a week of training, Culver's canoe team opened fall season Sept. 17 at Wab with a 16-mile race.

THE TEAMS OF Lee Robin and Bill Brewer, and John Martin and Randy Reich, both paddling together for the first time, took third and sixth place respectively, a considerable achievement since the opposition has been racing for the entire summer.

Veteran CAG canoeist Carl Kahn and Barb Stevens, a newcomer, made their debut as paddlers in this race.

Facing a real test of skill and stamina at Brookville the following weekend, Culver paddled a 10-mile race that included six stages. Robinson and Brewer came in 4th while Martin and Reich once again placed 6th. Kip Cheldine and John Greengoss, 1st starters in the season, took 7th.

THE INDIANAPOLIS race this weekend will wrap up the season. At 10 miles, the race will be better suited to the team's ability at this time. Coach Philip Mallory, pleased with the team's record in the face of heavy competition, is very optimistic about the upcoming race.

Canoeists Race in Crawfordsville

Last weekend the canoe team raced in Crawfordsville, Ind. Saturday morning started off with a 1,000 meter C-1 sprint, an Olympic - style event where one man paddles on the same side of the canoe for the whole race. Placing fifth was Lee Robinson, with Bill Brewer placing eighth, followed by teammates John Martin, Kip Cheseldine, and John Greengoss.

LATER THAT afternoon on 11 mile mixed race, a race in which

both sexes paddle, was held. In a class of 40 boats, Barb Stevens and Lee Robinson placed 15th. Carol Kahn and John Greengoss finished 37th after conveniently smashing two gigantic holes in John's new boat.

Sunday the team paddled down Sugar Creek for 16 miles with 180 other boats. Kahn and Stevens took 7th place in their event; Robinson-Brewer placed 4th, with Martin-Reich, Greengoss-Cheseldine, and Flynn-LoCastro placing 6th, 8th, and 9th, respectively.

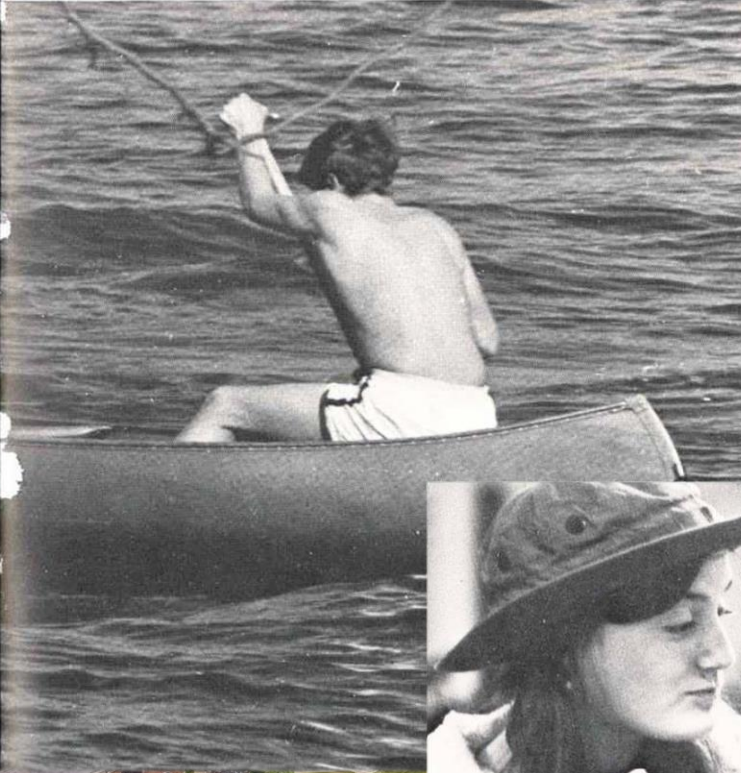
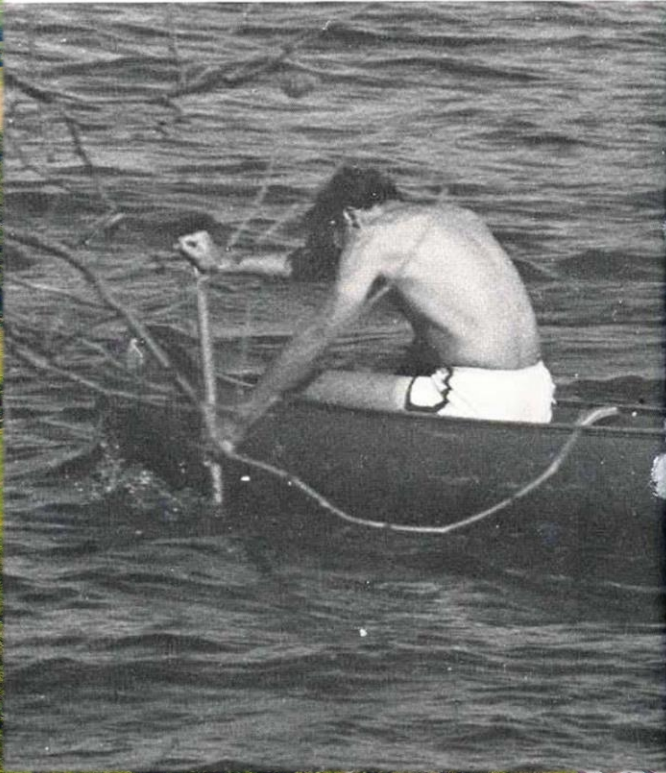

Lack of time and opportunity for conditioning and practice, a perennial problem, appeared to be no deterrent as CMA students, and recent alumni took five of the top ten placings. Led by Lee Robinson in third place, Kip Cheseldine and John Greengoss took sixth, along with Bill Brewer, paddling to a seventh place in c-2 Junior Men's competition.

Newcomer Barb Stevens, paddling with veteran Carol Kahn adjusted well to the stern position. Randy Reich and John Martin, also a new combination, along with Greg Sharkey, comprised the remainder of the team.

The team looked forward to a good spring season with a strong base of returning lettermen, new boats, and increased activity in C-4, C-1 and mixed competition.
