Canoeists Race in Crawfordsville

Last weekend the canoe team raced in Crawfordsville, Ind. Saturday morning started off with a 1,000 meter C-1 sprint, an Olympic - style event where one man paddles on the same side of the canoe for the whole race. Placing fifth was Lee Robinson, with Bill Brewer placing eighth, followed by teammates John Martin, Kip Cheseldine, and John Greengoss.

LATER THAT afternoon on 11 mile mixed race, a race in which

both sexes paddle, was held. In a class of 40 boats, Barb Stevens and Lee Robinson placed 15th. Carol Kahn and John Greengoss finished 37th after conveniently smashing two gigantic holes in John's new boat.
