Three More Canoe Races

Although the canoe team has lost such great canoeists as Lee Robinson and Bill Brewer, they have come up with six excellent canoeists to take their place.

With only two varsity lettermen returning, three top flight canoes have been formed. The number one canoe is paddled by Mike Perbix and Jim Faulkner, who are also the team's captains. The number two canoe is paddled by Dartanian Warr and John Andersen, and the number three canoe is paddled by Chris Conner and Bill Newcomb. The team has three more scheduled events.


Two weeks ago the canoe team went to Sugar Creek in Crawsfordsville, Ind, where five Culver canoes took part in the 16-mile race. Four canoes finished but took only one place in the top 10 canoes.

Last Saturday in Alpha, Ohio, on the Little Miami River 10-mile race, the Culver canoeists seemed to come into their own. Mike Perbix and Jim Faulkner took second, and Dartanian Warr took third in the C-2 Junior Men's Cruiser Event. Then, to top off an already good day, Chris Conner and Bill Newcomb placed first in the C-2 Junior Men's Novice race. They started four minutes late in a field of 19 canoes and finished 20 seconds behind the third place canoe.

The canoe team competed in four meets with some very good results. At Alpha, Ohio, Chris Conner and Bill Newcomb took a first in the C-2 Junior Men's Novice race, and the boats of Mike Perbix and Jim Faulkner, and Dartanian Warr and John Andersen, took second and third in the 6-2 Junior Men's Cruiser event. Finally, the Andersen and Warr canoe was first in the Aluminum Boat race at Greenville, Ohio, while the one of Newcomb and Conner was first in the Crui-Vedette 6-1-75 ing Event.
