# Canoeers finish well in midwestern races

The canoe season has gotten under way with Coaches Doyle Roysdon and Scott Ebright at the helm; The turnout was excellent and the team has been practicing sprints, portaging, racing around the lake and has taken a few trips to practice on the Tippecanoe River.

The co-captains for the boys are Bill Newcomb and James Faulkner and the captain for the girls is Laura Vanderkolk.

In their first race, April 25, the team took part in the 14th Annual Sugar Creek Canoe Race in Crawfordsville. In the Junior Men's Division they placed: 7th—

James Faulkner and Chris Conner, 8th—Dave Scott and Bill Newcomb and 9th—Bruce Haber and Henry Zahner out of 13 contestants. Coaches Roysdon and Ebright stated, "This is a nationally known race and brings in some of the finest competition around. Therefore, we feel the team did quite well for its first race."

The team went to the 1976 Ohio State Championship in Greenville May 2, where they entered in three classes. In the Junior Men's Cruiser Race James Faulkner and Chris Conner placed 4th, Dave Scott and Bill Newcomb were 5th, Bruce Haber and Henry

Zahner were 7th and Tom Kill and George Keegan were 9th.

In the Women's Cruiser Race Martha Held and Candy Carnaby came in 4th, and in the Bear's Mill Novice Aluminum, Bruce Wade and Heinz Hamman placed 8th out of 13.

The team will participate in the 6th Annual St. Joseph River Run May 8 in South Bend. The race will be approximately 11 miles long. The Don Bullock Memorial Trophy will be given to the first place team in the High School Novice Open which Coach Ebright said they thoroughly expect to win.
