UMG ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNITED MONARCHY OF GIEZWA (GOVERNMENT-IN-EXILE)

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization shall be The United Monarchy of Giezwa (Government-in-Exile) ("UMG").

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The United Monarchy of Giezwa (Government-in-Exile) is established to function as the sovereign Government-in-Exile of The United Monarchy of Giezwa (UMG). It serves the public welfare through cultural preservation, nation-building, humanitarian aid, educational advancement, economic empowerment, and international recognition efforts on behalf of UMG. This corporation shall operate within the guidelines of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE III: REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of this nonprofit corporation shall be located within the State of Minnesota, United States of America, as filed with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE IV: MEMBERSHIP

The membership shall consist of Citizens of The United Monarchy of Giezwa, governed by the Royal Constitution, Citizenship Decrees, and the authority of the UMG Monarch Dynasty Family.

ARTICLE V: GOVERNANCE

The Sovereign Monarch, His Majesty King Giezwa Monarch Jr., shall hold supreme authority as Head of State. The Monarch Dynasty Council and Royal Court shall govern the entity's affairs in

alignment with Royal Decrees, UMG Bylaws, and the UMG Royal Constitution.

ARTICLE VI: INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, this organization shall indemnify any officer, director, or agent against liabilities incurred through lawful performance of their duties.

ARTICLE VII: DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution, any remaining assets shall be distributed exclusively for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to a government entity for public purposes.

ARTICLE VIII: ROYAL RECOGNITION

These Articles of Incorporation are ratified under the Sovereign Authority of His Majesty King Giezwa Monarch Jr., pursuant to the Royal Constitution, Royal Bylaws, and binding Decrees of The United Monarchy of Giezwa.

ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS

These Articles may be amended only by Royal Decree of His Majesty King Giezwa Monarch Jr., Sovereign Monarch of The United Monarchy of Giezwa.

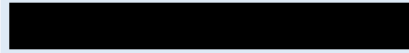

PREAMBLE

The United Monarchy of Giezwa (UMG) adopts this Public Institutional Edition to state the principles that guide its internal nonprofit, dynastic, cultural, ceremonial, educational, humanitarian, developmental, and administrative framework. This edition preserves the central themes of the Founding Era Constitution while clarifying that UMG operates subject to applicable law and that its internal titles, institutions, decrees, and processes do not by themselves create external governmental jurisdiction or internationally recognized sovereign-state status.

ARTICLE I - RIGHTS, DIGNITY & FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

UMG affirms dignity, fairness, freedom of expression, freedom of belief, equal treatment, peaceful participation, due process within internal organizational procedures, and respect for lawful private enterprise and property rights.

Nothing in UMG policy authorizes discrimination, violence, coercion, or conduct prohibited by applicable law.

ARTICLE II - INTERNAL INSTITUTIONAL STRUCTURE

UMG may maintain executive, advisory, legislative-style, judicial-style, ministry, council, court, archive, ceremonial, and administrative bodies for internal organizational purposes.

Any UMG tribunal, court, assembly, ministry, or council is an internal institutional body unless separately established and authorized under applicable external law.

ARTICLE III - THE MONARCH & ROYAL HOUSE

The Monarch serves as UMG's principal dynastic and institutional leader within the organization's internal framework.

The Royal House preserves continuity, cultural identity, institutional history, ceremonial leadership, and long-term stewardship. Titles used within UMG are internal or ceremonial designations unless recognized by another lawful authority for a separate purpose.

ARTICLE IV - SUCCESSION & REGENCY

Succession is governed by the UMG Crown and Succession framework and is intended to remain within the direct descendant line of the founding Monarch, subject to internal eligibility, merit, continuity, and documented lineage requirements.

Where a Queen or other authorized Regent is designated, regency may preserve continuity until succession is completed under UMG internal law. Private lineage, biometric, inheritance, and family records remain confidential unless specifically approved for public release.

ARTICLE V - REPRESENTATIVE & ADVISORY PARTICIPATION

UMG may establish assemblies, councils, appointed families, committees, advisory bodies, and community representatives to provide consultation, expertise, continuity, and institutional accountability.

Participation in such bodies does not confer public office or governmental authority under external law.

ARTICLE VI - RULE OF LAW & HOST-JURISDICTION COMPLIANCE

UMG internal rules govern UMG organizational matters only to the extent lawfully permitted.

Applicable federal, state, local, foreign, and international law controls wherever it applies. No UMG rule may require a person to violate applicable law or disregard the lawful authority of a court, government, regulator, licensing body, or other competent authority.

ARTICLE VII - CITIZENS IN WAITING & MEMBERSHIP

UMG may maintain an internal participation and membership framework known as Citizens in Waiting.

Citizens in Waiting status is not sovereign-state citizenship, nationality, immigration status, diplomatic status, or recognized passport/travel status. Rights and responsibilities arise only within UMG's lawful organizational framework.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENTS & CONTINUITY

This Constitution may be amended under internal procedures approved by the reigning Monarch and any bodies designated by UMG governing instruments.

Public editions may be updated to reflect legal review, institutional development, corrections, superseding policies, or changes required for compliance. Historical originals shall be preserved in the Founding Era archives.

ARTICLE IX - ADMINISTRATIVE & DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS

UMG may use internal geographic, ministry, project, province, district, city, or development designations for planning, cultural, ceremonial, archival, or project-management purposes.

Such designations do not establish territorial jurisdiction, land title, municipal authority, or governmental control unless separately created through lawful host-jurisdiction processes.

UMG may support entrepreneurship, employment, investment, commerce, development, charitable initiatives, and lawful property ownership through properly organized entities and programs.

All financial, investment, tax, securities, employment, real-estate, and commercial activity is subject to applicable law.

ARTICLE XII - EDUCATION

UMG may support education, scholarship, historical study, entrepreneurship, technology, cultural learning, and future educational institutions where lawfully established.

ARTICLE XIII - HEALTH & HUMANITARIAN WELFARE

UMG may pursue humanitarian, health, wellness, relief, and community-support initiatives through lawful partnerships, programs, charities, providers, and institutions.

ARTICLE XIV - ENVIRONMENT & NATURAL RESOURCES

UMG supports environmental stewardship, clean water, sustainable development, agriculture, renewable energy, responsible land use, and preservation of natural resources.

ARTICLE XV - SPEECH, EXPRESSION & PUBLIC INFORMATION

UMG supports peaceful expression, public information, transparency, historical preservation, and respectful debate, subject to applicable law and reasonable internal rules protecting privacy, safety, intellectual property, and organizational integrity.

ARTICLE XVI - RELIGION & SPIRITUAL BELIEF

UMG recognizes freedom of religion and belief. Spiritual or ceremonial traditions within UMG do not displace the religious freedom of participants or applicable law.

ARTICLE XVII - EQUALITY BEFORE INTERNAL RULES

UMG internal policies should be administered consistently and in good faith, with reasonable procedures for review, correction, and appeal within the organization where appropriate.

ARTICLE XVIII - SOCIAL WELFARE & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

UMG may pursue social-welfare, charitable, humanitarian, educational, cultural, family, and community-development initiatives consistent with its lawful nonprofit and organizational purposes.

ARTICLE XIX - SAFETY, SECURITY & PROTECTION

UMG may establish internal safety, risk-management, ceremonial-guard, event-security, and protective policies.

Any private-security activity, armed activity, investigation, emergency response, or protective service must be conducted only by persons or entities properly authorized, trained, licensed, and acting within applicable law. UMG does not claim independent police or military authority in the United States or any host jurisdiction.

ARTICLE XX - INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS & COOPERATION

UMG may pursue peaceful communications, professional consultation, cultural exchange, development relationships, humanitarian cooperation, investment discussions, and other lawful international engagement.

Any treaty, diplomatic relationship, governmental agreement, concession, autonomous arrangement, territorial status, development approval, or international recognition exists only when formally established through the appropriate legal and governmental process.

ARTICLE XXI - PROTECTION OF PERSONS & THE ROYAL HOUSE

UMG condemns threats, violence, stalking, harassment, fraud, and unlawful interference directed at any person, including members of the Royal House.

Safety concerns shall be addressed through lawful protective measures, private-security services where properly licensed, civil remedies, law enforcement, courts, and other competent authorities. UMG internal documents do not authorize corporal punishment, capital punishment, vigilante action, or unlawful retaliation.

ARTICLE XXII - SEVERABILITY, INTERPRETATION & PUBLIC STATUS

If any provision is invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable under applicable law, the remaining provisions should be interpreted to remain effective to the greatest lawful extent.

Its public role is limited to functions that may lawfully be performed by UMG members, event staff, volunteers, contractors or properly licensed security professionals.

CEREMONIAL FUNCTIONS

- Honor guard and ceremonial presence at UMG events where lawful.
- Protocol support, guest guidance, archive stewardship, event logistics and non-enforcement safety assistance.

PROTECTIVE FUNCTIONS

- Risk identification, emergency planning, access coordination, safeguarding of records and property, and liaison with licensed professionals or public authorities.
- Any regulated protective service must be performed only by appropriately licensed and authorized persons or entities.

HISTORICAL BRANCH NOMENCLATURE

- Founding Era LPC documents used military-style branch names as part of UMG's internal conceptual structure. Those names are historical/internal designations and do not create corresponding branches of the U.S. Armed Forces, public police, coast guard, national guard, or any other governmental service.

HOST-LAW COMPLIANCE

- The LPC public framework is expressly subordinate to applicable civil, criminal, licensing, employment, weapons, privacy, emergency-management and security law in every host jurisdiction.

CONFIDENTIALITY

- Operational security details, personnel files, credentials, routes, vulnerabilities, access controls and restricted protocols are not published in the public governing library.
