This public edition deliberately omits private lineage evidence, DNA and biometric information, dates of birth, addresses, school information, medical information, private estate or inheritance information, and confidential family records.

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I. Purpose of the Succession Master Volume

The purpose of this standalone volume is to place the UMG Monarch Dynasty's public succession framework into one clear record. It expands on the shorter public Crown & Succession edition by presenting the public dynastic surname standard, title definitions, public succession register, ceremonial designation process, continuity structure, and archival principles in a form intended for direct public review.

The Founding Era Royal Addendum established coronation, lineage continuity, succession eligibility, title classifications, preservation of names, the Ruling Tree, and a public list of heirs. This edition preserves those public-facing concepts while removing private or legally sensitive provisions that are unnecessary for public understanding.

SOURCE STATUS

This volume is a public institutional edition. Historical originals remain preserved in UMG archives. Where an original provision is private, security-sensitive, punitive, or inconsistent with applicable external law, the public edition states the institutional principle without reproducing the restricted provision.

II. Founding Crown & Dynastic Continuity

The succession framework begins with the founding Monarch, King Giezwa Monarch Jr. The Crown framework is intended to preserve continuity through the founder's direct descendant line, subject to the Crown Law, public succession instruments, lawful amendments, and formal designation by the authorized UMG Royal House.

The Queen participates in the continuity framework through ceremonial, advisory, and regency functions recognized by UMG governing instruments. During a lawful transition, the Royal House may use a regency or continuity arrangement to preserve internal administration until the successor is formally installed.

UMG succession is not designed as automatic strict eldest-child primogeniture. Readiness, merit, continuity, character, training, the governing succession instrument, and formal Royal House designation may be considered.

PUBLIC STATUS

The Crown and Royal House described here are internal UMG institutional and dynastic structures. This volume does not claim that a Royal title creates public governmental office or state-recognized nobility.

III. The Monarch Surname & Dynastic Name Standard

The surname MONARCH functions within UMG as the principal dynastic family name and ceremonial identifier of the UMG Monarch Dynasty. The Founding Era succession decree states that official royal descendants are to bear the surname 'Monarch' in legal and ceremonial records associated with UMG.

For this public edition, minor Royal descendants are identified by their approved public or Instagram dynasty names rather than by their full civil names. Full names are intentionally withheld at this stage and may be published later as part of the permanent dynastic and genealogical record of The UMG Monarch Dynasty. Any legal change of surname remains governed by the applicable civil jurisdiction.

NAME STANDARD

UMG cannot independently change a person's legal name. 'Monarch' may be used as an internal dynastic or ceremonial designation only to the extent lawful, and a legal surname remains whatever is established by applicable civil records until lawfully changed.

Public naming convention used in this volume:

- Approved public or Instagram dynasty name is used for minor Royal descendants in this public edition.
- Royal or dynastic title is shown together with the approved public dynasty name.
- The surname 'Monarch' may appear as a public dynastic designation without representing that a civil legal-name change has occurred.
- Full civil names, identity-document numbers, private name-change records, and other sensitive identifying information are withheld from the current public edition.

IV. Core Succession Principles

Dynastic Continuity

The Crown is intended to remain within the founding Monarch's direct descendant line, subject to governing succession instruments and lawful amendments.

Not Strict Primogeniture

The oldest child is not automatically required to become the next ruler. Selection may consider readiness, merit, continuity, character, training, and formal designation.

Formal Designation

Succession standing may be clarified, changed, or confirmed through an authorized UMG public succession instrument or formal Royal House announcement.

No Automatic Transfer of Property

A succession position does not by itself transfer private property, trusts, businesses, estates, intellectual property, or financial assets.

Public Privacy Standard

The public register does not disclose confidential lineage evidence, DNA, biometrics, medical information, addresses, dates of birth, or private estate information.

V. Royal Titles & Public Classifications

Crown Prince / Crown Princess

A public dynastic title used for a descendant designated within the succession line or prepared for a future Crown role. The exact standing is controlled by the current succession instrument.

Prince / Princess

A Royal House title identifying a direct descendant or other recognized member of the UMG Monarch Dynasty under internal UMG rules.

Ruling Crown

A training or preparation designation described in the Founding Era record for an heir being prepared to assume the Crown when formally selected.

Emperor / Empress

An internal senior dynastic title that may be used following retirement of a reigning King or Queen after a successor is installed, where recognized by the governing Royal House instrument.

Monarch Advisor

A senior Royal House or dynastic advisory role associated with institutional memory, counsel, or historical preservation.

Guardian of the Heir

An internal ceremonial or stewardship role associated with preparation and protection of the designated successor.

TITLE NOTICE

UMG Royal titles are internal dynastic and ceremonial classifications. They do not independently confer diplomatic immunity, governmental office, legal privilege, or recognized nobility under external law.

VI. Public Succession Register

The following register is based on the named heirs and succession descriptions contained in the Founding Era Royal Addendum. It is presented as a public historical and institutional record. It may be updated by a later authorized succession instrument, and this edition does not disclose private evidence used in internal lineage review.

VII. Coronation, Designation & Preparation of an Heir

The Founding Era succession record contemplates a formal Royal Coronation recognized within the UMG Monarch Dynasty. A successor may be installed only after internal confirmation of eligibility, readiness, continuity, and the requirements of the applicable Crown Law.

The ceremony may include a Royal oath, anointing, participation by the reigning Monarch and Queen, witnesses from the Royal House and Seven Appointed Families, and creation of an archival record.

The source record also describes the reigning King crowning the heir and the Queen participating in the anointing, followed by formal preparation of the selected successor. The public edition treats these steps as ceremonial and dynastic traditions rather than as acts that create external governmental authority.

Preparation of a Designated Heir

- Education in UMG history, governing documents, institutional structure, ethics, and public responsibility.
- Ceremonial preparation and understanding of Royal House traditions.

- Service through appropriate institutional, cultural, educational, humanitarian, or development responsibilities.
- Mentorship by the reigning Monarch, Queen, senior Royal House members, and designated advisors.
- Public confirmation when a succession designation becomes official.

VIII. Regency, Retirement & Continuity

A regency or continuity arrangement may be used where authorized by the Crown Law during incapacity, minority of a selected heir, temporary inability to serve, or a transition between rulers. The Queen or another formally designated Regent may preserve internal UMG continuity within the scope of the governing instrument.

The Founding Era record also describes a senior dynastic tradition in which a retiring King may assume the internal title Emperor after installing a successor, and a retiring Queen may assume the internal title Empress. In this public edition, those titles are treated as ceremonial and dynastic seniority designations.

CONTINUITY RULE

No regency, retirement title, or succession designation overrides legal guardianship, custody, estate administration, corporate authority, or any other rights governed by external law.

IX. The Ruling Tree & Royal Archives

The Founding Era decree establishes a Ruling Tree Book as the historical record of ruling lineages descending from the founding Monarch. The archive is intended to preserve each generation, public titles, succession classifications, appointed responsibilities, and the continuity of each branch of the Royal House.

For public release, the Ruling Tree uses a privacy-minimized format. Minor descendants may be shown by an approved public or Instagram dynasty name, Royal title, lineage branch, and succession classification while full civil names, private evidence, and identifying information remain withheld until an authorized later publication.

Their role in succession is advisory and ceremonial within UMG. They do not independently determine legal parentage, civil inheritance, external governmental office, or rights under public law.

SUCCESSION WITNESS

Where used in a coronation or succession ceremony, the Seven Appointed Families may witness the internal UMG designation and preservation of the record. Formal succession standing remains controlled by the current authorized Crown instrument.

XI. Privacy, Public Updates & Amendment

Because a dynastic succession record can involve children and family relationships, the public version follows a deliberate privacy standard. Only information necessary to explain the public Royal House structure and succession framework should be published.

Amendment Standard

A public succession amendment should state the date, the authority issuing the update, the provision or register entry being changed, and whether the update supersedes a prior public designation. Historical versions should remain archived rather than erased.

XII. Public Certification & Closing Record

This Royal Succession Master Volume is intended to serve as the standalone public succession reference for The UMG Monarch Dynasty. It consolidates the public principles of Crown continuity, surname practice, titles, heir designation, coronation, regency, the Ruling Tree, and the named succession register preserved in the Founding Era record.
