Vanguard Scholar is built for every student who wants to learn — regardless of how they access the web. We aim for content that's readable, navigable, and usable with assistive technology, including screen readers.

What we do.

We use clear heading structure, plain language, and high-contrast text against our off-white and indigo colour palette. Images include descriptive alt text where possible. PDFs are built with a real text layer, not just scanned images, so screen readers and text-to-speech tools can read them aloud.

Where we fall short.

We're a small, mostly-automated operation, and some of our content — particularly the interactive HTML lessons with checkboxes and quizzes — may not be fully screen-reader-friendly yet. We're aware of this gap and treat it as a genuine limitation, not a footnote.
