Practice Question Quest

Best revision? Test yourself before the teacher does. Today, we'll use AI to turn one textbook chapter into 10 practice questions — then you answer on paper first.

The game: beat the answer key

Reading the chapter again feels safe. Testing yourself feels risky. That is exactly why testing works better. Your brain remembers more when it has to pull the answer out, not just recognise it on a page.

AI will make the practice paper. You will do the actual remembering.

1 Choose your chapter

Pick one real chapter. Not “the whole syllabus”. That monster is too big for today.

Use a textbook chapter, class handout, or your own notes. If you have the chapter digitally, you can paste it. If not, use the chapter title and key points from your notebook.

Your board

Example: CBSE / ICSE / State Board / IB

Your chapter or notes

Paste notes here, or write the chapter title. Example: Life Processes — nutrition, respiration, transportation, excretion.

THOUGHT BULB

A chapter title works. Your own notes work better. AI can create sharper questions when it sees what your teacher actually covered.

2 Copy the practice-question prompt

This is the main move. Paste it into ChatGPT, Claude, or Gemini.

COPY-PASTE PROMPT

I'm a Class [X] [board] student. Make 10 practice questions from this chapter, mix easy and hard, with an answer key at the end: [paste chapter or title].

Copy prompt

WHAT YOU SHOULD ASK AI FOR

10 questions — not 50. You want useful, not endless.

Easy + hard mix — warm-up questions and brain-stretch questions.

Answer key at the end — so you can hide it while answering.

CAUTION BOARD

Do not read the answer key first. That is like watching the movie ending and then pretending you solved the mystery.

I copied the prompt and replaced the class, board, and chapter parts.

3 Generate your mini test

Paste the prompt into your AI tool. Wait for 10 questions and an answer key.

Your AI output should look roughly like this. It does not have to match exactly.

Easy

Define photosynthesis in one sentence.

Medium

Why is chlorophyll important for plants?

Hard

Explain how photosynthesis and respiration are connected.

Answer key should be at the end.

That makes it easier to cover the answers and try the questions honestly first.

Hide the answers. Seriously.

The whole game works only if you answer before you check.

Copy only the questions into a new document, or scroll so the answer key is not visible. Better: write the question numbers in your notebook and answer on paper.

THOUGHT BULB

Active recall means forcing your brain to produce the answer. It feels harder than re-reading because it is actually doing the work.

Answer on paper first

No typing into AI. No peeking. Just you, paper, and the chapter monster.

Try every question. For anything you do not know, write “not sure” and move on. That is better than staring at one question for six minutes and losing the whole match.

SCORING SYSTEM

2 points = correct without help

1 point = partly correct or remembered after thinking

0 points = not sure yet

CAUTION BOARD

This is not a marksheet. It is a map. A zero is not an insult. It tells you exactly what to revise next.

6 Check, circle, revise

Now use the answer key. This is where the revision plan appears.

Check your answers honestly. Circle the questions you missed. Those are not failures. Those are your next revision targets.

OPTIONAL FOLLOW-UP PROMPT

I got these practice questions wrong: [paste question numbers or questions]. Explain only these weak areas in simple English. Then give me 3 more practice questions on them. Do not give the answers until the end.

Copy follow-up prompt

WIN CONDITION

You win when you know what you do not know. That sounds annoying. It is also how good revision starts.

Closer: Answer on paper first. Then check. No peeking.
