Simple English Unlock

Paragraph reads like another language? Here's the unlock. Use AI to simplify it, then check that the meaning did not get lost.

Start the move

Copy the prompt

Level 1: Paragraph Survivor

Pick a hard paragraph

Open an AI tool

The mission

You are not asking AI to do homework. You are asking it to remove the fog from one difficult paragraph.

The win is simple: read the easy version, check the meaning, then go back to the original and understand it properly.

1 Choose the paragraph boss

Pick one paragraph that made your brain say, “Bro, what is happening?”

Good options: a textbook paragraph, a dense history passage, a science explanation, a newspaper paragraph your teacher gave you, or a difficult note from class.

CAUTION BOARD

Do not paste private information. No phone numbers, addresses, personal messages, marksheets, or anything you would not want floating around outside your notebook.

2 Open your AI tool

ChatGPT, Claude, or Gemini. Any one is fine.

Open a new tab. Use whichever AI tool your school or grown-up allows. Don't spend the whole session comparing tools. Today's move is the prompt.

THOUGHT BULB

AI is useful here because it can explain the same meaning in easier words. But it can also accidentally change the meaning. That is why we check.



I opened ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, or another approved AI tool.

Copy the simplify prompt

This is the main move. Clear, short, and hard for AI to misunderstand.

COPY-PASTE PROMPT

Rewrite this paragraph in simple English a Class 10 student can understand. Keep the meaning exactly the same:

[paste paragraph]

Copy prompt

WHY THIS PROMPT WORKS

It tells AI three things: who the explanation is for, what style you want, and the most important rule — keep the meaning exactly the same.

☐ I pasted the prompt into AI and got a simpler version.

4 Do the meaning check

This is the part most people skip. Don't.

Put the original paragraph and the simple version side by side. Check whether the simple version kept the same meaning.

Original paragraph

Usually longer. More formal. More textbook-ish.

Simple version

Easier words. Shorter sentences. Same meaning, if AI did its job properly.

CAUTION BOARD

Simple does not mean loose. If AI removes an important term, changes a cause-and-effect, or makes the paragraph sound more certain than the original, fix it.

Did any key word disappear?

Did the reason or cause
change?

Did AI add something new?

☐ I checked that the simple version kept the meaning.

5 Use the repair prompt

Only if the meaning changed. No drama. Just fix it.

If AI made the paragraph too simple and lost something important, paste this follow-up.

REPAIR PROMPT

You changed part of the meaning. Rewrite again, but keep these important terms and ideas:

[list the key terms or ideas]

Use simple English, but do not remove the original meaning.

Copy repair prompt

THOUGHT BULB

This is the real skill. You are not accepting AI's first answer. You are steering it.

☐ I used the repair prompt if the meaning got changed.

6 Re-read the original

Now go back to the hard paragraph. This is where it clicks.

Read the simple version once. Then read the original paragraph again. Slowly. The original should feel less scary now.

WIN CONDITION

If the original paragraph makes more sense after the simple version, the move worked.

☐ I re-read the original paragraph after reading the simple version.

Write the one-line version

Close the AI tab for two minutes. Your turn.

In your notebook, write the paragraph's meaning in one sentence. Your words. Not AI's.

My one-line meaning

Example: This paragraph means that...

SMALL ACTION

Read the simple version. Re-read the original. Then write one sentence in your own words. Done.

Quick recap card

Here is the AI Move of the Day version you can turn into a small card, poster, or 60-second video.

Hook: Paragraph reads like another language? Here's the unlock.

Move: Paste the paragraph into ChatGPT, Claude, or Gemini with the simple-English prompt.

Result: You get an easier version that keeps the same meaning.

Closer: Read the simple version. Then re-read the original. Write the meaning in one sentence yourself.

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
