Logic Gap Detective

Grammar check is easy. The real upgrade is checking your thinking. Today, we ask AI to find gaps, jumps, and unsupported claims in your essay.

Start the check

Jump to the prompt

YOUR CURRENT LEVEL

Level 1: Draft Holder

Pick an essay draft

Paste the logic prompt

Find the weak spot

Ask for repair options

Fix one gap yourself

Close with your edit

First, the important bit

AI should not write your essay for you. That is the boring shortcut. We are using it like a sharp reader who points at the weak part and says, “This bit needs more proof.”

You still write the essay. AI just helps you see where the thinking is shaky.

1 **Pick one essay draft**

Any subject works. History, English, geography, economics. Just make sure it is your own draft.

The draft does not need to be perfect. Actually, imperfect is better. This move is for catching the part that looks fine at first glance but does not fully make sense yet.

Essay topic

Example: Was the Non-Cooperation Movement successful?

Your main argument in one sentence

Example: It was successful because it united many Indians against British rule.

THOUGHT BULB

A logic gap is not a spelling mistake. It is when your essay jumps from one idea to another without a bridge. Example: “Many people joined the movement, so it was fully successful.” Wait. Did joining automatically mean success? That needs proof.

☐ I picked one essay draft that I wrote myself.

2 Tell AI what NOT to do

If you do not say this clearly, AI may start fixing commas like a very excited English teacher.

Open ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, or whichever AI tool your school allows. Then paste this prompt.

COPY-PASTE PROMPT

Don't fix my grammar. Point out where my argument has gaps, jumps, or claims I didn't back up.

For each issue, give me:

1. The exact sentence or idea that has the problem
2. What the logic problem is
3. What kind of proof, example, or explanation I should add

Here is my essay:
[paste essay]

Copy prompt

CAUTION BOARD

Do not ask AI to “make the essay better” yet. Too vague. It may rewrite everything. Today’s target is narrower: find the logic gaps.

☐ I pasted the logic-gap prompt into AI with my essay.

3 Read the AI feedback like a detective

The AI may give you many comments. Do not panic. We only need one useful catch.

Look for these three types of problems:

Gap

You made a claim but did not explain why it is true.

Jump

You moved from Point A to Point C and skipped Point B.

Unsupported claim

You said something big, but gave no example, quote, date, number, or reason.

Weak link

Your evidence is there, but it does not clearly prove your point yet.

MINI EXAMPLE

Draft sentence: “The movement failed because it was called off.”

Possible logic gap: Called off by whom? Why was it called off? Does calling it off mean the whole movement failed, or did it still achieve something?

Better direction: Add the reason it was called off, then explain what success or failure means in your essay.

☐

I found at least one gap, jump, or unsupported claim in my draft.

4

Ask for repair options, not a full rewrite

This is the difference between using AI to think and using AI to take over.

Pick one weak spot from AI's feedback. Then paste this follow-up prompt.

REPAIR PROMPT

For this one logic gap, give me 3 possible ways to fix it.

Do not rewrite the paragraph for me.

Just give:

1. What evidence I could add
2. What explanation I could add
3. One question I should answer before rewriting

Logic gap:

[paste the one issue here]

Copy prompt

THOUGHT BULB

Good editing is not “make it sound fancy.” Good editing is “make the thinking harder to poke holes in.”

☐

I asked AI for repair options without asking it to rewrite the whole essay.

Fix one gap yourself

Now we leave the AI tool and do the part that counts.

Choose one gap. Add one sentence, one example, or one explanation in your own words. Not AI's words. Yours.

The gap I found

Example: I claimed the movement failed, but I did not explain what failure means.

My fix in my own words

Write one sentence or small paragraph that repairs the logic.

WIN CONDITION

You win if your essay now has one stronger link than it had before. One fixed gap is better than ten grammar changes that did not improve the argument.

6 Optional: turn it into an AI Move card

This is the note-worthy reminder of the move you just learned.

CARD COPY

Title: AI Move of the Day

Move: Check your essay for logic gaps, not just grammar.

Prompt: “Don’t fix my grammar. Point out where my argument has gaps, jumps, or claims I didn’t back up.”

Closer: Fix one gap yourself, in your own words.

☐ I made, sketched, or saved the reminder card.

Final 5-minute move

Close the AI tab. Open your essay. Fix one gap yourself. That is the whole point.

☐ I did not ask AI to write the essay for me.

☐ I used AI to find weak thinking, not just spelling mistakes.

☐ I repaired one gap in my own words.
