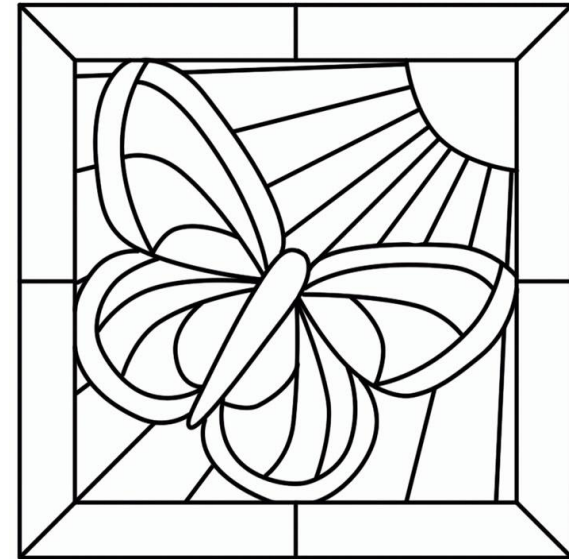

“Drawn In Week Four: Listen”

"Listen"

In our current worship series "Drawn In" we are exploring the powerful connection between faith and creativity. What we have said thus far is that for us to learn and grow in our faith we must: 1) DREAM about what God would have us be doing. 2) HOVER by not rushing into things but rather taking the time to think and feel. 3) RISK ourselves by allowing God's creativity to flow through us and then allowing our creativity to flow to others around us. This week we explore what it means to LISTEN.

The Wesleyan Covenant Prayer: I am no longer my own, but yours. Put me to what thou wilt, rank me with whom you will. Put me to doing, put me to suffering. Let me be employed by you or laid aside

for you, exalted for you or brought low for you. Let me be full, let me be empty. Let me have everything, let me have nothing. I freely and heartily yield all things to your pleasure and disposal. And now, O glorious and blessed God: Creator, Christ, and Holy Spirit, you are mine, and I am yours. So be it. And the covenant which I have made on earth, let it be ratified in heaven. Amen.

Monday 5.25 "The Transfiguration" Matthew 17:1-8

What does the voice of God sound like? The voice from heaven reported in today's reading suggests that when we listen to Jesus, we hear the voice of God. It is not all that difficult to read and hear the words of Jesus. To listen to and then obey those words is more demanding. How do you hear God's voice in your life?

Tuesday 5.26 "New Things" Isaiah 42:1-9

The last verse speaks about new things coming. As followers of Jesus Christ, we share the good news that God can be heard, understood, and obeyed. We have scriptures, nature, history, and the stories of our lives that speak God's truth. Even more, we have the ability to "hear" God's voice deep within our own souls. What is a "new thing" that you think might be happening in your life?

Wednesday 5.27 "Conformed? Transformed!" Romans 12:1-2

We are transformed into newness throughout our lives when we "renew our minds." What does that mean? It means that we are never finished thinking about new ideas and experimenting with new perspectives. Listening to God means that we are trying to perceive what God is saying to each of us. We are emerging into new ways of living. What does that look like for you?

Thursday 5.28 "Genuine Love" Romans 12:9-13

It is one thing to say that we love others. It is another thing completely to actually demonstrate that love by putting it into action. It is even more challenging to sincerely FEEL love as you live

it out. Practices and disciplines increase our desire and our capacity to be faithful to what we hear and know to be the voice of God. John Wesley called these practices a means of grace. This means that we have to actually practice ways that show God's love, will, presence, and power in really special ways. How do you do this?

Friday 5.29 "Bless" Romans 12:14-21

We are called to bless others. In our thoughts. In our words. In our actions. We can do this when we let go of trying to control those around. If we let God be in control, if we let God do the speaking and we do the listening, then love has the chance to live in our lives, our families, and our communities. Who can you bless today?

Saturday 5.30 "Clothe Yourselves" Colossians 3:12-17

Verse 12: "Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness and patience." Think about your own behavior. Do you intentionally try to live these words? Are you listening for the voice of God to make these happen? How could you take a step forward with these today?
