Monday 4.27
John 1:1-14

"The Word Became Flesh"

"Word." It has so many meanings. In this introduction to the Gospel of John, it literally is speaking of Jesus as God's Word... God's presence, God's voice. In prayer today lift up those who are searching and listening for God's voice today.

Tuesday 4.28

"The Two Ways"

Psalm 1

God's Law, another way of saying "God's Word" was incredibly important to the early Jewish people who were trying to walk in God's goodness and not human wickedness. It gave them direction and guidance in the lives they lived individually AND as an extended community as God's people. In prayer today, lift up those who are struggling between these two ways of living.

Wednesday 4.29

"The Voice in the Bush"

Exodus 3:1-12

Sometimes God's Word comes to us through the pages of our Bible. And sometimes throughout history, it has come as a literal voice. In prayer today lift up those who have heard God's Voice and Word and are seeking ways to live out their instructions.

Thursday 4.30

"Not by Bread Alone"

Matthew 4:1-11

Verse 4 says, "One does not live by bread alone, but by every WORD that comes from the mouth of God." From what you know of human history, what are some of the moments that people through the millennia have heard God's Word and put it into action? In prayer today, lift up those who are struggling to quiet their lives and seeking balance so they can hear God's Word.

Friday 5.1

"The Power of a Word"

Matthew 8:15-17

Jesus went to Peter's house and sensing evil in many of those who came to be healed "he cast out the spirits with a WORD." (vs16) Sometimes there is power in our many words, and sometimes the power lies in just a single word. When are moments that you witnessed people speaking with power because they spoke few words? In prayer today, lift up those who are struggling to speak and to be heard.

Saturday 5.2

"The Word Planted"

Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23

This is probably the oldest of Jesus' parables that we have. How do you see God's Word planted in each of the settings: path, rocky ground, weeds, and good soil? In prayer today, lift up yourself and your own journey to listen for God's Word.
