## TEACHING NOTES

### Assumptions

- #1 The Bible Says It – The Bible was written by God, sort of dictated by God.
- #2 I Believe it – The Bible is totally true; inerrant and literal.
- #3 That Settles it – The Bible should be accepted without question.

### Problems with these Assumptions

1. The Bible was \_\_\_\_\_ but not dictated by God.  
*“All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that everyone who belongs to God may be proficient, equipped for every good work.” 2 Timothy 3:16-17*
2. The Bible contains \_\_\_\_\_ even if it isn't totally true.
  - Genesis 2 God created man before vegetation; In Genesis 1 humans are created 3 days after God created vegetation.
  - Genesis 1: Creation happened over 6 days; Genesis 2 creation in one day.
  - Genesis 1: Male and female created at the same time; Genesis 2 God creates a man and later a woman.
  - Genesis 1 shows an optimistic view of humans (created good); Genesis 2 has a pessimistic view of humanity (sinful)
  - Genesis 1 uses the name Yahweh for God and Genesis 2 uses Elohim for Lord God.
