First we would like to thank you for choosing Creamk9s for your family. Our service is to provide high quality K9s to families and other organizations.

- CreamK9s is responsible for the 1st and 2nd round of shots
- It is the new owners responsibility for the remaining shots
- We deworm the puppies and consult with a vet to ensure the health of the litter before going to their new home
- Promptly find a good vet to build a relationship with, as your puppy will need thier next shots 2–3 weeks after pickup or delivery
- Keep the puppy in a crate on all vet visits (Puppies are new and can contract illness without shots) (off of the ground)
- To insure that your puppy does not contract outside illness please keep your puppy away from any place that you not 100 percent certain that a dog with parvo or any other illness has been (no walks or pet visits without crate until fully vaccinated and vet approved)
- Once the puppy leaves our care we are no longer responsible for any health issues (72 hour grace period)
- This is why we STRONGLY encourage each new owner to take the proper care of their new CREAM K9
- We encourage owners for the first two years to supplement their pet monthly with NuVet Vitamins
- Balance is due before receiving puppy
