 - The "armless archer" Matt Stutzman came to us to start a show to raise money for individuals with disabilities to drive. Matt won the Gold Medal at the 2024 Paralympics; he won the Silver in 2012. Born without arms, Stutzman uses his legs and feet for most of his activities, including archery. He holds a world record for the longest accurate shot in the sport. He also is a race car driver and drag racer.
 - I am very passionate about this as well. I own a business in Iowa called,
 Safer Driver Solutions/Driving for Exceptional Learners. We specialize in teaching individuals with disabilities to drive.
