Our vision is to create a society where women and girls have access to affordable period products and live in dignity without facing stigma. There are over 500 million women and girls who lack access to period products around the world. It is estimated in the UK period poverty rates is as high as 21%. Leicester, where we are based is ranked the 5th poorest city for period

poverty. This leads to consequences like dropping off of school or work, facing health risks and social stigma which also can lead to abuse. In countries such as Nepal women are even not allowed to touch food, or visit a temple during their menstruation. There are many cases studies including in the UK that shows that women and girls are using alternative products such as toilet paper and are also at times exploited for sex in return for period products.
