

CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS

- Aggression by dogs (or handler) will not be tolerated. The Club reserves the right to exclude any dog (or handler) showing aggression during training times subject to assessment by the Instructors. All incidents of aggression to be reported immediately to Instructors. Dogs assessed by Instructors to be aggressive or uncontrolled may be required to wear a muzzle.
- 2. No bitches in season allowed on training ground.
- 3. Dogs must be vaccinated in order to participate in training. Members have the responsibility to ensure vaccinations are kept up to date.
- 4. Members must clean up immediately if dog fouls ground. Handlers must carry plastic bags.
- 5. Foundation class members will receive a Club name tag which must be worn at all times during training.
- 6. Dogs must have a properly fitted flat collar with a leather or fabric lead (not a chain lead). Correction chains or halters are not permitted.
- Children under the age of 13 will not be permitted to train a dog without adult supervision.
- 8. Dogs are required to be on lead at all times unless under supervision of Instructors. Handlers must follow instructions of Instructors.
- 9. No smoking or alcohol permitted whilst on the oval.
- 10. Any point of dispute is to be taken to an Instructor or Committee Member.
- 11. All members participating in the first session will be required to arrive no later than 7.00pm to assist with setting up. All members participating in the second session will be required to arrive no later than 8.15pm to assist with equipment setup and packing up upon class completion. No help, no training.
- 12. Dogs under 15 months of age must be under constant control of an instructor to train on agility equipment. It is the handler's responsibility to advise the Instructor if their dog is under 15 months so training can be adapted.
- 13. All handlers and dogs must be physically able to train for Agility. Some dogs because of their size or weight can only join subject to Club assessment.
- 14. Sick or injured dogs should not be trained.
- 15. A club instructor must be present at all times for training on equipment unless by prior arrangement.
- 16. The Club accepts no responsibility for injury to handler/dog. It is your responsibility to ensure the safety of yourself and your dog(s) at all times.
- 17. Training may be cancelled to ensure dog/handler safety
- 18. Dogs MUST be crated if left unattended. Dogs MUST NOT be left tied to fences, or in a drop stay.
- 19. COVID-19 regulations in force at the time must be followed.
 - a. Handlers and visitors must be double vaccinated. Proof of vaccination must be provided.
 - b. QR Check-in is required.
- 20. The Club considers discrimination, harassment (including sexual, racial and disability harassment) and bullying to be unacceptable conduct. Members MUST NOT harass, intimidate, bully, threaten (emotionally or physically), verbally abuse or publicly criticise other members.
- 21. Dogs are not permitted in the pavilion.
