DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE ABOUT YOUR MAILBOX LIGHT, IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE IT'S WORKING.

Speeding continues to be the most reported issue in our community. The speed limit in LF is 15 mph. Some of you think 35 mph and up is acceptable in LF. Wait until it's too late and someone hits a walker, biker or another animal. We have enough problems with outsiders coming in our community and speeding, if you live in LF and you are a speeder, STOP SPEEDING BRFORE ITS TOO LATE!

As we close out the peak season, please talk with your guests who may be staying with you, about the rules that must be followed all over the park. We want our guests to enjoy our park, and we want our residents to be able to enjoy all the amenities without incidents or rude behavior by others.
