

LAKE FAIRWAYS LOCAL RULES

Hole #3: If ball comes to rest outside the roped off area on the right, it must be brought in within two club lengths of the point of entry no closer to the hole. Penalty one stroke. Players are not permitted to enter the roped area.

Hole #6: On the right side of fairway there are many areas with tree roots and bare spots. This is deemed "ground under repair" area.

Holes 7 & 8: Fences are out of bounds line. No free drop

Hole 9: If a ball crosses the penalty line on the right side of hole 9 you may not enter the penalty area. Take a drop two club lengths from where the ball entered the penalty area and no closer to the hole. One Stroke

The red stakes on holes 14 & 15 define property lines. The ball must be brought back on to the course and played within two club lengths, no closer to the hole, from the point where it crossed over. One Stroke

Perimeter roads define out-of-bounds on Holes #3 and #12. Re-hit shot where last shot was taken. Stroke and Distance

Penalty areas: If your ball fails to cross the water you may use the drop zones on holes 11, 16, 17 and 18. One stroke penalty. Additionally, if you put your ball into the second water on eighteen on your drive, you must bring your ball back as per the rules of golf for entry into the red penalty area. One Stroke

Holes 3, 6, 13 and 18 have areas where debris from the hurricane has not been picked up. Those areas will be considered "ground under repair". You may bring your ball out of that area to the nearest point of relief, one club length, no closer to the hole or ball can be played from ground under repair, no penalty per USGA rules.

Immovable Obstructions: Player may take line of play relief if positioned behind stairway on hole #13. Relief is one club length no closer to the hole from the nearest point of relief. No Penalty

Free drops from tree roots, fire ant hills and protective fences on holes 3, 6, 15 and 17. Otherwise USGA rules apply.

Cart path only on holes 1,2,5,7,12, 16 and 17. Otherwise 90 degrees

CURRENTLY OUR SAND TRAPS DO NOT HAVE ANY NEW SAND IN THEM, THEREFORE, IF YOU GET INTO A SAND TRAP, YOU MAY RAKE THE AREA WHERE YOUR BALL LIES, THEN PLACE YOUR BALL, NO PENALTY. YOU MUST PLAY THE BALL OUT OF THE SAND TRAP
