Our youngest recipient was an infant who had fetal open-heart surgery and our oldest was 66 years old.


### **How Donations were Spent**

## Type of Financial Assistance Provided

100% of recipients needed assistance with household expenses.

78% of recipients needed help paying for pharmacy, equipment and hospital/physician hills.

48% of recipients received funds for tolls, gas, and car repairs.

2% of recipients needed help paying for end of life celebration costs.

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### **Collective Impact**

100% of Financial Assistance applicants received monetary assistance, a list of social service resources in their geographic area and the opportunity to connect with someone else who has traveled the CHD journey.

Of these recipients, 82% also received Wellness Resources (connections to therapeutic resources) and 48% were provided with special gifts for siblings of the child with a CHD diagnosis.

228 infants, children, teens, and adults hospitalized in Pennsylvania and Delaware cardiac care units received new, bright, and colorful pillowcases and blankets during our Pillowcase & Blanket Campaign in August 2023.
