OUR HISTORY



Founded on July 1, 2010, in Quincy as a 501(c) nonprofit, the Asian American Association of Boston (AAAB) was created to celebrate culture, strengthen community connections, and promote Asian American arts and heritage. After relocating to Boston in 2012, the organization expanded its programs to include cultural festivals, artistic performances, and international exchanges. A major milestone came in 2016, when Massachusetts state and Boston city leaders officially designated the second Saturday of September as “Asian American Day,” recognizing AAAB’s growing impact. Through annual festivals, charity events, and community partnerships — including virtual programs during the pandemic — AAAB continues to unite diverse communities while showcasing the richness and contributions of Asian Americans across Greater Boston.






