

NOTICE OF INTENT TO IMPOSE AN INCREASE/ DECREASE IN LEVIES
LIMA SCHOOL DISTRICT #12
 March 12, 2019

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Lima School District #12 Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose permissive levies to support its budget. Per Senate Bill 307, state law requires the District to provide notice of its intent to increase/decrease these permissive levies in the upcoming fiscal year. To ensure financial transparency and avoid confusion, the District has chosen to analyze the estimated impact of all its levies, voted and permissive.

The Lima School District #12 estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019:

The District intends to use the permissive Building Reserve levies listed above to address the following items:

- Addressing any facility improvements and repairs identified in the 2019 facility inventory completed by the District, as required by 20-9-502, MCA
- Upgrades to the District's Network Infrastructure
- Addressing Septic/ Plumbing Problems and Improvements

Forecasting the District's tax impact for the ensuing fiscal year requires a number of variables and an analysis of projections, historical trends and anticipated projects, therefore the information provided above is strictly an educated estimate. Once the District's FY20 budget is adopted in August, an updated notice will be posted.
