- Encourage the reuse and recycling of materials, where practicable and possible.
- Encourage staff to distribute internal and external documentation electronically.
- Provide sufficient training in environmental aspects of work, to ensure that staff are aware of the actions required to eliminate or minimise the impacts of those aspects.

We demonstrate our commitment by implementing an Environmental Management System which provides a framework for setting and review of environmental performance objectives and targets and meets the requirements of ISO 14001:2004 – Environmental Management System.

This policy is reviewed regularly to ensure and improve its effectiveness in meeting legal requirements and planned environmental outcomes. It is communicated to staff at induction and during daily toolbox talks and is available to staff and other interested parties on the company web site.
