La Paz County Supervisor D.L. Wilson announced today that he will be seeking re-election in District 1 as a write-in candidate.

“To the people of La Paz County District 1, after careful consideration and at the urging of numerous people, family and friends and with much thought and prayer, I will seek Re-Election to District One La Paz County Supervisor.”

“Things have really changed since June when I initially decided not to seek re-election” said Wilson. He added that “The introduction of federal legislation last Friday which would enable the County to purchase additional BLM land for solar development presents an opportunity that was unforeseen. That is in addition to the issues from the COVID-19 pandemic which will affect County operations and finances for the foreseeable future. While I felt change was in the best interest of myself and the County last June, these, for better or worse, are not the changes I contemplated.”

D.L. has been deeply involved in the La Paz Land Conveyance concluded in May, and in the successful negotiations with a world-class solar developer for development of the 5,900 acres already acquired by the County. The additional 4,800 acres contemplated in the La Paz Solar Development and Job Creation Act of 2020 will ensure the financial stability of La Paz County for the foreseeable future.
