

Invicta Ukulele Club Rules & Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

The Invicta Ukulele Club exists to bring together people who enjoy playing, learning, and sharing ukulele music in a friendly and inclusive environment.

2. Membership

- Membership is open to anyone with an interest in the ukulele, regardless of skill level.
- Members must register with the Club Membership Secretary.
- Members agree to follow these rules and contribute positively to the group.

3. Conduct and Respect

- Treat all members with kindness, respect, and patience.
- Constructive feedback is welcome, but criticism should be polite and encouraging.
- Discrimination, bullying, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.

4. Equipment and Instruments

- Members are expected to bring their own ukulele and tuner.
- Shared equipment (if borrowing someone else's) must be handled with care.
- The club is not responsible for personal instrument loss or damage.

5. Music and Meetings

- Song choices are usually made by club members or the club host.
- Members are encouraged to suggest new songs and arrangements.
- Sheet music or chord charts provided by the club are for personal use only unless stated otherwise.

6. Fees and Subscriptions

- A small fee may be collected to cover venue hire, sheet music, or other expenses.
- Fees are non-refundable except in exceptional circumstances.
- Members will be notified in advance of any changes of fees.

7. Health and Safety

- Be mindful of cables, stands, and other potential trip hazards.
- Follow all venue health and safety guidelines.
- In case of emergency, follow the instructions of the club host or venue staff.

8. Media and Privacy

- Photos or videos may be taken for club promotion (e.g. social media, posters).
- Members who do not wish to appear in media must inform the club in advance.

9. Amendments

- These rules may be updated periodically by the club committee.
- Members will be informed of any changes in advance.

10. Agreement

By joining The Invicta Ukulele Club, members agree to abide by these rules and conditions and abide to the venues terms and conditions, which can be obtained on our website.
