
SUE MCBRIDE



There are two green bins near the entrance to the school, accessible from the driveway, for textile donations. School does not need to be in session to access the bins. They will take ANY kind of fabric, but please, put it in plastic bags before depositing it in the bins. The textiles go to mills that recycle and repurpose the fabric into "new" fabric. **Hooray for upcycling!**

Bloc Loc Rulers Video Tutorials (courtesy of Barb Levan)

To find the video tutorials for the rulers, go to eeschenck.com. In the UPPER LEFT HAND CORNER, there is a box that looks like a tag and it says "Project Spotlights". Click on the box. Project Spotlights will come up. Click on the Bloc Loc spot. That will take you to many of the Bloc Loc rulers. MOST of the rulers shown will have a video with Janna Thomas demonstrating each ruler.

If you need a video tutorial for a Bloc Loc ruler that is not on this site, google Bloc Loc with the name of that ruler, and you'll find the tutorial. Look for the ones with Janna Thomas. There are others demonstrating, but some of those aren't very good.
