

# THE VOICE OF M2C VILLAGE

## PURPOSE IS GREATER THAN ADVERSITY

Over 30 years ago, I witnessed a passionate young woman with an extraordinary vision organise an event on a remarkable scale. The plans were in place, momentum was building, and the sense of expectation was palpable. Then, without warning, everything unravelled when the principal backer withdrew their support. What followed was a journey to Brighton in an attempt to salvage what had gone wrong, alongside numerous debriefing conversations. Sadly, many chose gossip and misplaced blame rather than offering understanding, encouragement, or prayer.

While I was acutely aware at the time of the profound impact this experience had on Melanie, I could never have imagined the potentially tragic toll it might take. Yet God intervened. He granted her a Second Chance – a chance to live and not to die, and ultimately a chance to share that powerful testimony with countless others.

It has been an honour to walk this journey with Melanie, my sister, over the years as she has turned that Second Chance into purpose. From deep personal pain, she has established **My 2nd Chance** as an organisation of hope and restoration, impacting lives both in the UK and in Ghana..



This milestone marks not only 30 years of business, but 30 years of faith, perseverance, and transformation – a living testament to what can emerge when purpose is greater than adversity.

## NAVIGATING TRAUMA COURSE

The impact M2C has had on myself has been phenomenal. My sister and I had the pleasure of attending the **Navigating Trauma Programme** after a period of bereavement, where we lost our mother and brother. The course helped me to process the trauma of grief and journey through the range of my emotions. It allowed me to be open along with other attendees on the course. The facilitators were excellent. They were not only knowledgeable, skilled and extremely professional, but their delivery was exceptional. The structure, sequence of vignettes and overall well-timed segments of the course are a model for other providers. We were all able to express our individual pain/trauma without judgment in a very relaxed and supportive environment. To say that I highly recommend the course is an understatement.

Having collaborated on a previous mission trip to Malawi in 2024, I am confident that Rev Melanie Hamilton will bring the same high-level passion, organisation and resourcefulness, to the Ghana Mission 2026. It will undoubtedly be an exciting and memorable experience for those engaging to go.



The year 2025 was indeed a phenomenal year for My 2nd Chance. It marked a defining chapter in our Ghana Foundation (M2C Ghana Foundation), which started as My 2nd Chance Ghana. In May, our Great ComMission team from UK, led by the Visionary and Director, Rev. Melanie Hamilton, visited Ghana and launched our Resource Centre (RC).

The launch was not only the beginning of the RC but that of our organisational presence in Ghana as well. The RC was secured as a residence for one of our beneficiaries, with a transitional plan to move her into independent living once the Centre became fully operational. By September, this transition was completed, marking a milestone in our mission to provide stability and opportunity. To our beneficiary, Rev. Rebecca A. Mante, the transition did not only symbolise a new home but a new and great beginning. As an organization, the transition switched us into full operation, setting the tone for the months that followed.

Before the RC launch, the Foundation had no staff presence in Ghana. The first administrator was interviewed and introduced on the day of the RC launch, marking the start of our staffing journey. By October, we had grown from zero staff to five; the first administrator becoming our Resource Centre Officer and PA to the Director, working alongside four dedicated community workers, each entrusted with specific responsibilities in health, fundraising and marketing, outreach, and tuition.

This was a rapid expansion that came with both opportunities and challenges. Staff issues, including the need for training, role clarity, and resource allocation, were part of our early struggles, but they also reflected the growth and seriousness of our mission. This progress demonstrated our commitment to building a strong local team to carry forward the vision.

The ComMission team that came out in May gave their all. They reached out to orphanage homes, held conferences, partnered with churches to organise revival programmes and touched lives beyond imagination. These missionary works extended the Foundation's impact beyond the RC, touching lives across communities and strengthening our ties with local partners. It was a season of planting seeds of hope and service, laying a foundation for future growth.

We also acknowledge and reciprocate gratitude to Rev. Rebecca A. Mante and her family. In her own words, she expressed, "Thank you dearly for the residence and the smooth transition. You made me feel loved." Her heartfelt appreciation reflects the significance of the RC launch and the stability it provided her.



## MAKING A DIFFERENCE

**TUTORING AND EDUCATION SUPPORT**  
We believe that education is a cornerstone of empowerment. Ernest Oppong, an alumnus of Jackson College of Education, brings passion and dedication to his role in overseeing our tuition programmes. Jeddiah Odankor, our Resource Officer, shares his commitment; he works closely with Ernest to champion our adult education programme - ensuring that no one is left behind in the pursuit of knowledge.

**HEALTH SCREENING AND WELLNESS**  
Health is not just a service - it's a commitment to dignity, access, and informed care. Coordinating our health outreach is Sophia Eno Hawkson, a certified midwife and dedicated community worker. A graduate of the Nursing and Midwifery Training College, Freetown, Sophia brings deep compassion and clinical expertise to her role, especially in supporting mothers through childbirth and promoting holistic wellness.

**WEDNESDAY COMMUNITY DROP-IN**  
Our Wednesday Drop - In sessions are a cornerstone of this mission. These weekly gatherings offer free health screenings to all community members, including vital checks for blood pressure, sugar levels, malaria, and typhoid. We also host health talks and hygiene education sessions to promote long-term wellness and preventive care.

## FOOD AND NUTRITION

Food insecurity remains a pressing challenge for many in our community. At M2C Ghana Foundation, we respond to this need through our weekly Drop-In sessions and seasonal outreach programmes. These initiatives provide essential food items to families and individuals facing hardship. Clothing is also more than a basic need - it's a source of dignity, comfort, and protection.

Coordinating this effort is Tracy Amashah Rock, a second-year Public Relations Management student and our Outreach Leader. While quarterly shipments of food and clothing arrive from our UK headquarters, local support remains vital to meet growing demand and sustain our impact.
