

LAUNDRY BREAKDOWN FOR THE TRIAL:

MAKE SURE ALL PERFORMERS ARE OUT OF THE DRESSING ROOM BEFORE YOU BEGIN FEBREEZING COSTUMES!!!

Women

- Wash all tights, shapers, socks, and slippers every night. Anything that touches the body should be washed every day. (Please ask questions if you are unsure of whether something should be washed.)
 - Make sure tights are washed in a laundry bag, and that they are not tangled into a ball.
 - Wash all the women's dress shirts every night.
- Any suiting (suit jackets, skirts, suit pants, suit shorts) should be turned inside out, and sprayed lightly with Febreze.
 - All other garments are to be turned inside out, spot cleaned, and left to dry overnight.
 - Remove Briana Osmond's cufflinks from her shirt prior to washing.

Men

- Wash all socks, undershirts, and dress shirts every night.
- All suiting (jackets, vests, dress pants, all other pants, judge robe, and overcoats) should be turned inside out and sprayed with Febreze.
 - Spot clean makeup off hats as needed.
- Men's suiting will need to be steamed with the steamer as needed throughout the run of the show.
 - M. Delaflor's suits should be steamed and pressed before every performance.

SHOW LAUNDRY:

- After every show, all performers should put what they want washed in their laundry bags, and wardrobe crew will pull any additional items that need to be washed.
- You will separate the laundry into lights and darks
 - apply starch to the collars of the dress shirts to remove the makeup stains prior to washing them
 - Wash on large size load in cold water
 - The next day, a member of the crew will come in and swap the clothing to the dryer. Once dry, press and starch the dress shirts, and return everything back into the dressing room.
