

# JCGC MINUTES

## 6-30-2022

President Kelley called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM at 1st Presbyterian Church.

Blair Yount read the minutes of the March 31, 2022 meeting. Roy Osborn moved to accept, Steve Shumaker 2nd and the motion passed.

Curtis Grace gave the financial report. There was a update to the overage as reported in the March minutes. The correct amount is \$275, not \$457. There was a check that had not cleared then, but now has. Jim Buchanan moved to accept, Lloyd Eargle 2nd, and the motion passed.

Tom Tabor was nominated to be the nominating chair. Mike Bowler and Livingston Kelley's terms will be up this fall.

The club championship tournament was discussed. Billy Noell moved to play the championship on 2 consecutive Mondays, 18 holes each. Mike Bowler 2nd and the motion passed. Livingston and Tom Tabor to determine the courses and date.

The Golf banquet will be held as usual at 1st Presbyterian Church. The date will be determined later.

Mike Bowler noted that the club is NOT playing by USGA rules and should be. Lift, Clean and Place is used more than it should be. Without LCP a ball CAN NOT be moved without a 1 stroke penalty. If you feel it has to be moved, declare an unplayable lie.

Sand traps need to be played. If you can't or don't want to play from the sand, declare unplayable, drop behind and take 1 stroke. The coordinator needs to be sure all players are aware of the rules.

Steve Shumaker moved to discard the current HIO procedure and replace with the following. 1. Move the HIO fund money to the general fund, doing away with

the HIO fund. 2. All HIO payouts will be \$500, paid from the general fund. 3. The general fund will be maintained to at least \$1000 to cover 2 HIO payouts. Roy Osborn 2nd. and the motion passed.
