#### Analysis:

Based off of other records we have with Howard and Jennie, we can estimate his birth date around 1865. The following record indicates his birth around 1858. Census records are notorious for having distorted birthdays because the older an individual got in age the less they could actually remember when they were born. This is a strong lead because the names of children repeat in Howard's own

immediate family with Jennie Lucky. This is a tradition in many families to pass down the names of children from generation to generation. The location of tHoward at this time is also paramount because it shows consistency in his residence near Sparta, Hancock County, Georgia.

Analysis: The afore transcribed census magnifies the inconsistencies off birth dates, places, and even names. Fortunately we see Howard in the household, but not the age he should have been after 10 years. We can infer this is the correct family due to the same members of the family in the correct location at the time. Notice, Isaac's name has changed to Isaiah, and Narcissa to Kizzie. This is an indication that emancipation led them to change their names or perhaps their names were not taken correctly on the 1870 census.

Analysis: Very rarely I find that a person could be enumerated on the census twice and on the same page, if you view image #2, you'll see that Howard and his brother is listed in both his father's household as well as his own. We also have strong confirmation that his is the correct Howard because living next door is Jennie Lucky in the accompaniment of her uncle and aunt. Remember, Howard and

Jennie were not married until 29 Dec 1880.<sup>5</sup> This census was recorded on 9 June 1880, therefore it would make sense for them to be living in two separate households.

#### **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:**

All research performed was exhaustive. To solidly confirm Isaiah/Isaac Reynolds is the biological father of Howard Reynolds, a DNA test would be required. See "recommended further research" for next targets if contracted for further research.
