#### **Conclusion:**

From my research, I was able to gather that Eugene M. Gregory was passing for white. In fact, he claimed to be on four federal census' consecutively. He was a lawyer who had a general practice in New York City which allowed him to accumulate wealth and leave a legacy in addition to the precedent for prosperity which was set by his father James Monroe Gregory, as he was also a professor at Howard University.

I was able to locate his tombstone that indicated a daughter and mentioned her young death. On the same stone, her mother, Minnie Ockrey is mentioned as having died the same day, therefore I dug a little deeper to see if there was a connection in their untimely death in the local newspaper article or obituary entry for the two. Without hardship, I was able to locate the article below.

# "Attorney's Wife and Daughter Asphyxiated"

Montclair, N. J. - Counsellor Eugene Gregory, at 119 Lincoln Street, Montclair, N. J., Attorney for corporations in New York went home last Tuesday evening expecting to be met at the station by his wife and baby as was their custom, and as they failed to meet him, he went home and went in the house to wait for them. He waited for one hour and still no sign of them, he thought he would go out into the garage to get the car to bring them home and when he opened the garage door, he discovered his wife and baby sitting up in the car, where they had been overcome by carbon monoxide gas. Mrs. Gregory was the former Miss Minnie Ockrey, who was a nurse with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Co., and the baby would have been three years old this month. They formerly lived in Newark, but moved to Montclair so that they would have a larger lawn for the baby to play. Mrs. Gregory was the Counsellors second wife, his first wife being the former Miss Musette Brooks, who died five years ago.

# Attorney's Wife and Daughter Asphyxiated

Montclair, N. J .- Counsellor Eu-Gregory, 119 Lincoln gene M. street, Montclair, N. In April of 1929 he marries Annie Wilkins and never has any children with her. Therefore, I decided to see if any of his siblings had kids who were still living. Without out a doubt, his younger brother, <u>Thomas Montgomery Gregory</u>, who has a legacy of his own expanded upon in "<u>The Thomas Montgomery Gregory Collection</u>" at Howard University, has one living daughter who resides in Washington, D.C. Her name is Sheila Gregory Thomas.
