**A Note From Rick:** Markets as a whole showed the first signs of weakness in a long time. The calf market showed the biggest drop, falling \$100 to \$150 per head. Butcher cow prices showed the least amount of decline, being \$3-\$5 lower. Mixed fat cattle ranged from \$2.20 to \$2.30 while Holsteins were in the mid \$1.90's. Dairy prices were slightly lower as well with a limited test. Not sure what to make of all this, but I will say that cash prices didn't fall as far as the board of trade. There is definitely some uncertainty in the markets & we haven't dealt with that much in 2025. Have a great week & we'll see you soon at TLA!!
