The good 90lb. to 100lb. calves brought \$10.50/lb. to \$11.50/lb. consistently. This is up a bit in price compared to the last couple of weeks, & is probably an all-time high for a large quantity of calves in that price range. The cross calves were steady along with butcher cows and fat cattle. Thursday's Springer Sale was strong & steady throughout as well. Although prices weren't quite as high as last month, the dairy cattle market shows no signs of slowing down anytime soon, in my opinion.
