A Note From Rick: Markets were mixed this week at TLA. On Tuesday, prices were a little better across the board compared to a week ago. Butcher cows, fat cattle & baby calves continued to rebound after the dip in prices a few weeks ago. Feeder cattle were not really tested, but they will be next week at our Special Feeder Sale. The hay market has picked up in volume & prices are strong. The majority of the hay ranged from \$200-\$300/ton. The market on Thursday at the Special Springer Sale struggled. Prices were very inconsistent throughout the sale. I'd say the cattle were graded harder than they've been in a long time. This resulted in certain types of heifers (close up heifers, average or below average quality heifers, etc.) with a big drop in prices. I guess it was the dairy cattle markets' turn to take a hit like the beef market did a few weeks ago. It'll be interesting to see if it bounces right back like the beef market has done.
