A Note From Rick: Markets continue to be a little softer this week at TLA. We had our special feeder sale for July this week and had a few groups of Holstein heifers as well as Holstein/Angus Cross steers to test the market. In both instances, prices were lower compared to the last few months. The Holstein heifer prices aren't too concerning to me. It's the middle of summer and there is normally a limited demand for cattle this time of year. Springer and Fresh Cow prices are still strong and we still have supply issues long term. The feeders for beef purposes on the other hand are not going to be able to sustain prices we've had earlier in the year. Fat cattle and calf prices have dropped significantly and that is going to back up feeders as well. It's been a long, long time since we have had a correction like this in the beef market, so we shouldn't be surprised. At this point, I don't think it's any major crash in the market, just a correction. Hope to see you soon at TLA!
