**A Note from Rick:** Markets on Tuesday seemed to pick up right where they left off 2 weeks ago. Butcher cows are still in a bit of a slump, with the better cows in the high 60's and low 70's. The calf market was steady as well with the better bull calves ranging from \$1.30 to \$1.60. Angus Holstein cross calves were strong as well ranging from \$2.30 to \$2.90 per pound. The dairy cattle markets will be tested in the next couple weeks with our Special Springer Sale on the 10th and Special Feeder Sale on the 15th. We had a tremendous Draft Horse Sale at the end of October. It was a week filled with highlights each day. It was a record breaking sale with the highest ever Clydesdale sold at public auction at \$100,000 and the 2nd highest Belgian Mare ever sold at public auction at \$75,000 (TLA also holds the record for the highest selling Belgian Mare). We definitely want to thank all of the consignors and buyers for giving TLA the opportunity to market such a great group of horses. None of it would be possible without all of our hardworking employees and community members for all of their efforts. It takes a lot of work and commitment from a lot of people to pull off a sale like this and the entire crew here at TLA stepped up and hit it out of the park. The concession stand and restaurant crew were able to feed the masses with smiles on their faces and the barn guys ran many miles throughout the barns stalling and lining up horses. Restrooms were cleaned, stalls were mucked, aisles were swept, bleachers were cleaned, trash cans were emptied..... the list goes on and on. We couldn't be more proud of TLA and this facility.
