**A Note from Rick:** Markets continue to be very active this week at TLA. Springers and fresh cow prices were steady on Tuesday. The calf market was stronger this week. Angus Cross calves ranged from \$3.00-\$3.35/lb. Holstein bull calves brought from \$1.40-\$1.70/lb on calves weighing 85 lbs and up. Feeder cattle, as well as Holstein replacement heifers, were a little softer this month at the Special Feeder Sale. I'd say that the recent drop in springer prices had a big effect on Holstein heifers as well as continued high feed prices. Butcher cows were a little stronger this week for the first time in several weeks. Hopefully this is a sign that maybe the big Fall run of cattle coming to market is coming to and end and we can continue this upward trend on prices. The hay market has been a bit more active over the last couple of weeks, which is to be expected this time of year. Along with more hay and a bigger variety, we've had stronger prices. I would say that prices are up \$30-\$50/ton across the board. The demand for turkeys and hams is going to go through the roof this week, so make sure you get yours early! We are definitely looking forward to gathering with our friends and family this week. From our family to all of yours, we wish you a blessed and Happy Thanksgiving.
