A Note from Rick: Mixed markets at TLA this week. We had a good run of feeder cattle to test the market. Prices on feeder cattle were a little softer compared to the last several months. Holstein heifers were steady and maybe even a little stronger in some cases. Neither of these changes come as a surprise. Live cattle and feeder cattle prices on the Board of Trade have slipped off considerably in the last 6 weeks. Springers and fresh cows have gotten stronger in the last couple months, so this all makes sense to me when these changes trickle down to younger cattle. The calf market has held pretty steady through this with Holstein bull calves and crossbred calves staying strong. Butcher cows were a little stronger this week as they seem to be slowly regaining momentum after a dip in the market in October. Fat cattle also held steady compared to recent weeks. Hope you all had a great Thanksgiving weekend as we head into December with some winterlike weather. The Dutch Cross Classic coming up in December will close out our horse sale schedule for the year and planning for next year's calendar is already underway. See you at TLA!
