A Note from Rick: No major changes in the markets this week at TLA. The hay sale continues to grow, as it usually does this time of year. Prices have been steadily stronger. The hay that was bringing \$100-\$150/ton this summer is bringing \$150-\$200/ton. Something that I have notices is we are not getting as much #1 quality hay. We have had a few loads here and there, but so far we haven't seen much of it. What we have had has brought \$240-\$280 over the last couple weeks. On the livestock side, we had a nice jump in butcher cow prices this week. Not sure how much the Thanksgiving holiday had to do with this and we'll find out next week. The calf market was a little up and down this week. Holstein bull calves were stronger. Holstein heifer calves were steady and Angus/Holstein cross calves were softer. Not sure there is anything to this really other than an odd week. I look for the crossbred calves to bounce right back moving forward. We had a light test in the feeder market along with fat cattle. The 2023 calendar is set and at the printers. We are looking forward to many exciting sales in 2023, but before we get there we still have a couple exciting ones left this year. The Dutch Cross Classic is December 9-10 and the Miller Yoder Standardbred Auction is on December 27th. Hope to see you at TLA!
