**A Note from Rick:** Markets steady at TLA this week. Very little change to report in any of the markets on Tuesday. The one market that stood out to me was the hay market. As we get into the busy season for selling hay, we're seeing prices that are a little stronger than last year. Prices on good quality, coarse hay are \$200+/ton. I would say on the average that's \$40 to \$60/ton higher than a year ago. The good quality, finer stemmed hay is ranging from \$260 to \$300/ton, which again is \$40 to \$60/ton higher than last year. We still aren't getting big amounts of hay coming in, so it will be interesting to see what prices do as the volume picks up. My guess is that prices will hold steady, and if anything, I could see them get a little stronger. Hopefully you all had a great Thanksgiving with your family and friends!
